### **School Attendance**

If the percentages are coloured red, they are below our whole school target of 93%. If they are coloured in green, they are equal to or above our 93% attendance target for the whole school.

As you can see the last few weeks of low attendance has resulted in the school's attendance rate for the year to date dropping 1.5% below our target of 93%.

We are working closely with our Education Welfare Officer for persistent absenteeism and families will be contacted soon to support an improvement in attendance.
