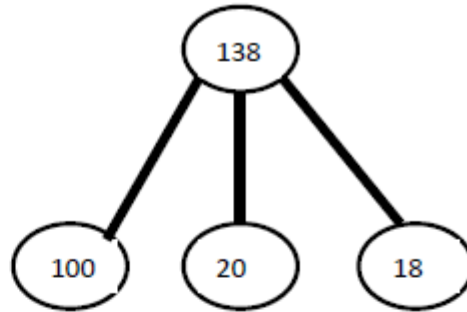

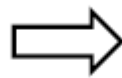

buckles	Clips used to fasten belts or straps.
ceremonial	Special objects used in important events or rituals, not everyday.
embossing	A way to raise designs on the surface of an object.
garnet	A red gemstone used to make jewellery.
gold	A shiny, valuable metal used to make jewellery and treasures.
helmet	A hard hat worn by warriors to protect their heads.
iron	A strong metal used to make tools and weapons.
inlay	A way of putting one material inside another to make a pattern.
ornament	A small, pretty object used for decoration.
shield	A large object used to block attacks in battle.
silver	A shiny, valuable metal used to make jewellery and coins.
