Activities

Activity 1: Understanding Afterlife Beliefs

Information Box: Afterlife Beliefs

Many religions have different beliefs about what happens after we die. For example:

- **Christianity** teaches that believers go to heaven or hell based on their faith and actions.
- **Islam** believes in a Day of Judgement where individuals are rewarded or punished based on their deeds.
- **Hinduism** teaches about reincarnation, where the soul is reborn into a new body based on karma.
- **Buddhism** also believes in rebirth, but focuses on achieving enlightenment to escape the cycle of rebirth.
