## Fox Class Weekly Newsletter Friday 3rd March 2023



#### **Fox Class activities**

In **Maths** our topic is measurement (length and perimeter). The children used both metre rulers, centimetres rulers to measure each other's height. We also measure small objects using the unit of millimetres.

In **English**, we have started to read 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes. First the children drew pictures of what they thought the Iron Man in the story looked like, then we read the text and children compared their drawings to the Iron Man's description in the book. We discussed its size being enormous, immense, gigantic and gargantuan. We also used similes to describe Iron Man as being tall as a house. The children have been learning about writing using the poetry devices of onomatopoeic words (words that sound the same as the word it describes) for

example, thump, clatter, click and kapow. We also wrote questions we would like to ask Iron Man and during role play, with a partner, the children were able to play the role of Iron Man to answer each other's questions.





In **Science**, our topic is 'Light and Shadows' and this week we were finding out about light reflecting from surfaces.







In **RE**, we learnt the meaning of Shrove Tuesday and Lent. The children discussed eating pancakes at home the day before Ash Wednesday.

In **Geography** we are learning about 'our world. The children really enjoyed creating their own globes, with balloons and a map. This week we looked at maps of Chessington to find St Mary's. The children filled in luggage labels to help them to understand the different

parts of an address e.g., street name, town/city, area, postcode and country.
