After school there will be a 'Light up the Night' disco for children from Wynstream to attend thanks to our PTFA.




A massive thank you to all the PTFA members- staff and parents who helped organise this. A special mention to Megan who has done so much in making the event a success.



School Attendance - Ongoing Reporting


















Year 5 trip to Exeter Customs House and the Quay on Thursday 10th November.

This term, in History, year 5 have been learning about Exeter's Customs House and the Quay.

As part of this learning, we have arranged a visit to the Quay and the Customs House, on Thursday 10th November. The trip will allow them to go inside the building and discover more about the history of the Quayside.

The Customs House has beautiful architectural features which were in style at the time of it being built. By visiting the focus of our local history study, the children have the opportunity to recap what they have learned and build on their existing knowledge.

Along with exploring the Customs House itself, we will have a look around the Quay and explore how the purpose of the area has changed over time. The activities we will take part in throughout the day will be a mixture of drawing, map skills and a quiz. We look forward to reporting back on how the trip went.




