All children can expect the adults at Spring Lane Primary School to follow the Protect, Relate, Regulate and Reflect approach, which means they:

- Treat others with kindness, calmness and consistency
- Give children space and time to talk about the feelings that drive their behaviour
- Support children to move around all areas of school calmly

SLP Way:

- Face forward when an adult is talking
- Empty hands when an adult is talking
- Follow instructions given by an adult
- Always tuck your chair in when leaving
- Stay in your chair during lessons
- Hands up to share ideas

Rewards:

- Catch me tokens (dot or star) for following the SLP Way consistently
- Values certificate for consistently showing our SLP values

Sanctions:

Step process

1. Reminder (x2) ➡ 2. Lose 2 mins. off free time ➡ 3. 2 choices given & free 5 mins. to make a choice ➡ 4. Timer on & wasted time paid back (incl. after school)

SLP values:

Resilience, Respect, Integrity

Helpful dialogue:

- I can see something has happened
- I'm here to help
- When you are ready to talk, I am here to listen
- You can come with me and talk about it or complete the work in your free time
- You can listen from there.
- Ask for help if you need it. I'm happy to help you.
