English

Phonics

Children will review their GPCs in preparation for their Year 1 Phonics Screening Check the following week.

We have sent some practice words home before half-term to look at with your child. Practice segmenting the longer words, sounding out the graphemes and blending the sounds to make the word (even if the child recognises the word).

Writing

Children will be retelling their own versions of traditional tales from around the world, writing in sentences and using more descriptive vocabulary.

Spelling & Grammar

We are continuing to develop sentence structures and punctuation, spell tricky words correctly and use the graphemes from our phonics in spelling words.
