We believe in the importance of reading and the curriculum has been designed around spotlight books. Each half-term we will use the spotlight books and children's interests as a stimulus for learning.

The Nursery Day

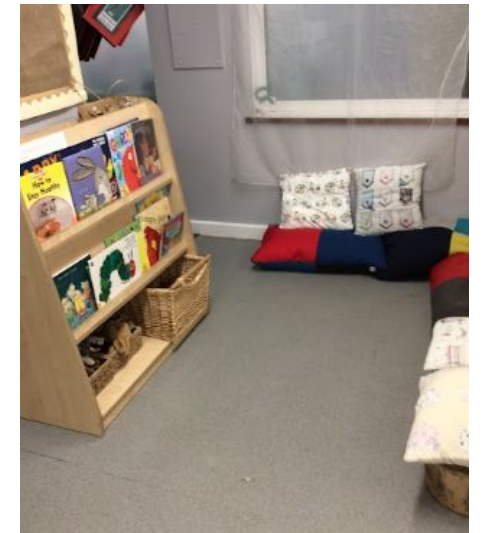
School begins at 8.45am and finishes at 3.15pm. You and your child will line up at the Reception outdoor area gates in the main playground and Miss Braidley will open the school doors to greet you and welcome your child into Nursery.

The children will have access to a range of activities throughout the morning. They will cover all areas of the EYFS curriculum. These may include independent activities for the children to access or adult-led activities. These will take place in the classroom and the outdoor area.

Snack time is on a free flow basis, the children select whether they have a snack and help themselves. They sit at the tables and have access to their water bottles or a cup of milk.

Lunchtime is at 11.45am. If your child stays for lunch they are taken into the school hall. If your child is only staying for the morning they will be taken to the side gate to be collected.

The afternoon session starts at 12.15pm and you will need to wait at the side gate. A member of staff will come and collect your child and take them into Nursery.

Lunchtime is from 11.45am - 12.15pm.

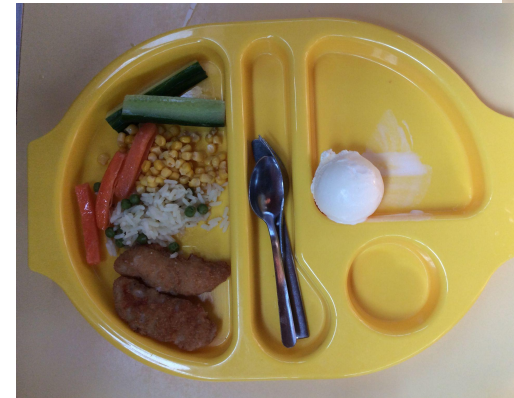
The children eat their lunch in the main hall and the nursery staff team support alongside the midday supervisors.

The children have the option of a hot dinner, a vegetarian hot dinner, jacket potato with cheese / beans / tuna, a cheese or ham sandwich.

Pudding is a homemade dessert / fruit or yoghurt.

The children choose their lunch when they enter nursery in the morning.

There is a three weekly menu that you will get a copy of when they first start.
