PROPOSED 20MPH SPEED LIMIT ON PART OF HERLWYNS AVENUE AND CROSIER WAY

As part of the Council's ongoing work to improve road safety and safe access, particularly outside schools, the London Borough of Hillingdon has been working on the proposals for a reduction of the speed limit outside Sacred Heart Primary School.

A plan has been drawn up for residents to inspect and the statutory consultation period will run from 11th November to 3rd December 2025. A formal notice will appear in a local paper as well as street notices displayed on site during this time. Plans indicating the proposed layout is attached to this letter for your convenience.

Your views are valuable so we welcome any comments you have and would like to receive them by 3rd December 2025. Please write to the postal or email address at the bottom of the page and include your address to help us analyse all responses.

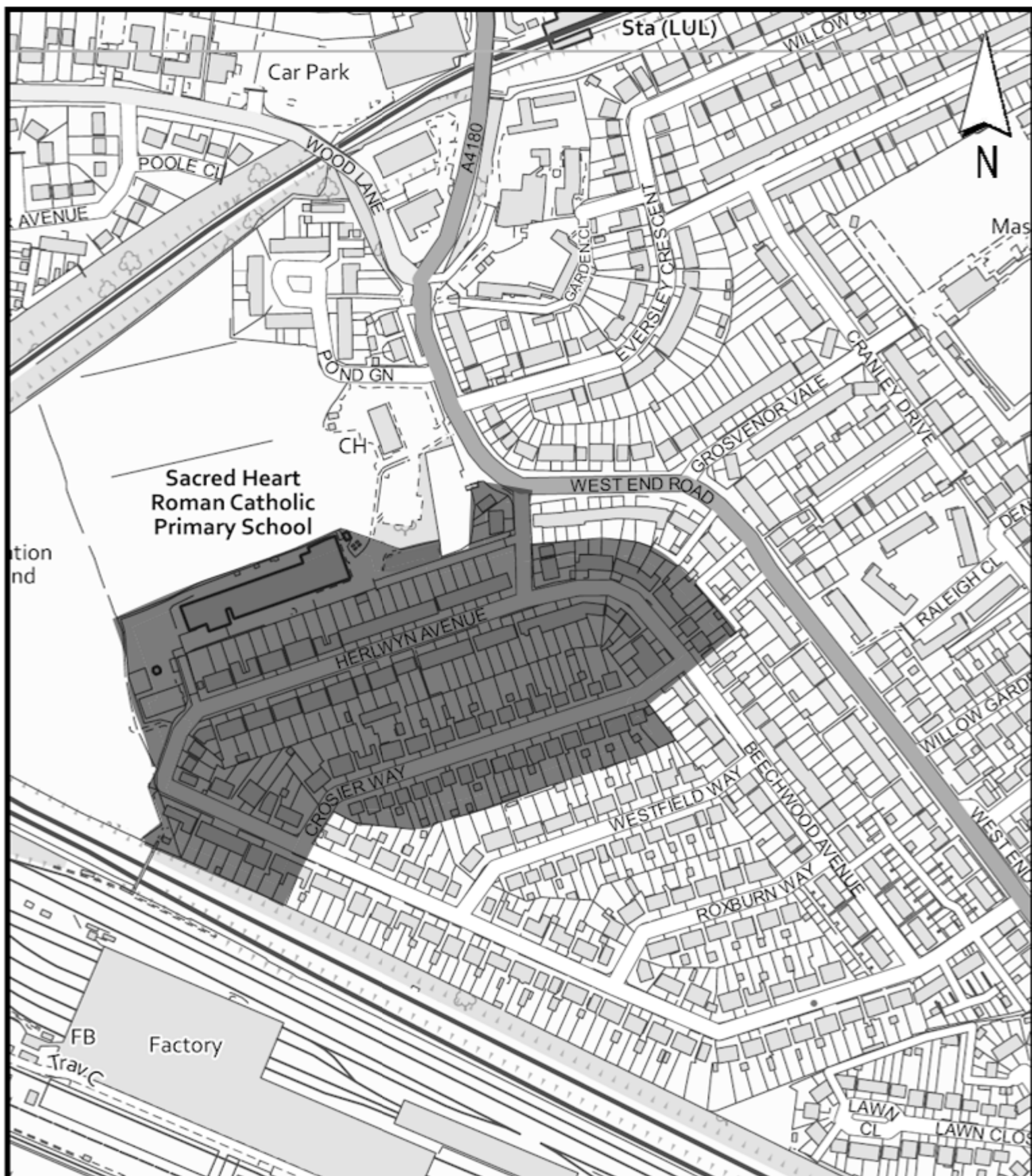
