Next week is anti-bullying week: 'Let's Make A Noise About Bullying' - starting 13th November
Next week is anti-bullying week. Children can wear odd socks on Monday 13th to celebrate
everyone's individuality. We will also be joining in a live assembly for World Kindness Day on
Monday 13th November and we will be using our PSHE sessions next week (and at other intervals
in the year) to discuss friendships and bullying.

We actively encourage children to not be silent when they see bullying take place, not be silent about the hurt bullying causes, and not be silent when we hear bullying dismissed as 'just banter'. We support children in choosing respect and unity and showing kindness to all. Together, we can make a difference and take a stand against bullying.

If you are ever aware that you child is being bullied, please talk to a staff member immediately or encourage your child to do this so we can take decisive action to prevent bullying. If you ever felt that the situation was not getting better, we do encourage you to keep in contact with us so we can support and manage the situation quickly and effectively.

Pupils' Choice Change of Lunch Menu

The children have voted for Chicken Goujons and chips (with ketchup!). All children in Year R, 1 and 2 can receive a free school lunch.
