<p>Locational knowledge</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Name and locate the world's 7 continents and 5 oceans. ● Name, locate and identify the capital cities of the UK and its surrounding seas ● Identify some characteristics of these cities e.g. landmarks.
<p>Place knowledge</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Understand geographical similarities and differences through the study of greater Manchester and Mbrara in Uganda.
<p>Human and Physical Geography</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Identify daily weather patterns in the UK ● Know the location of hot and cold areas of the world, the Equator and the Poles. ● Build on geographical vocabulary from Y1 plus cliff, coast, ocean, river, soil, valley, vegetation, village, farm, port, harbour.
<p>Geographical skills and fieldwork</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Record information in a variety of ways. ● Use simple maps, atlases and globes to identify locational knowledge. ● To use plan perspective (digimaps) to recognise landmarks and basic features. ● Use simple compass directions to describe maps ● Use simple keys on maps. ● Create and use simple keys on own maps.
