NURSERY

Applications for our Nursery January 2023 intake will be processed over the next couple of weeks. Please complete an application form, (available on the website), if your child will be 3 by 31st December 2022 and you would like them to attend our Nursery.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

Our after school clubs will be re-starting week commencing Monday 26th September, some of which are run voluntarily by the staff.

Please note that the sports clubs will be running a little differently this year. The club will change each half term, so that more children are able to access different activities. Each club will accommodate up to 20 children. Monday will always be a KS1 club, Tuesday Year 3/4, Wednesday Year 5/6 and Friday Year 3, 4, 5, 6. Mrs Reed has spoken to all the children to explain the new arrangements and she will keep a tracker of attendance to ensure there is equity for all children.

Please be aware that the link below will only allow parents to register for sports clubs for the autumn term. Mrs Manners will circulate a link for parents to sign up for sports clubs for the spring term in due course, and similarly for the summer term.

It is important to remember that the clubs do not run for all 39 weeks of the school year. There may also be times when an individual club is cancelled due to staff illness, inclement weather or external competitions etc, so it is really important that you do not rely upon the clubs as child care.

In the event of cancellation, we will inform you using the text messaging service, and keep your child safe until you collect them. Children need to want to do the club and are expected to attend each session. It is important that we know who will be staying for clubs each week.

If you think your child is at school and we think they have walked home there is every chance that your child could be at risk. It is important that all pupils inform the club leader if they are unable to attend, **via a note with a parental signature, via the home/school liaison book, email the office or inform the parent liaison officer on the gate** so that the registers account for all club members. This will ensure both you and we, know exactly where your child is.

The staff will complete the register and follow up all absences before beginning their club. A missing child may lead to the club being late starting, so your support in informing us if your child is not attending will be greatly appreciated.

Listed below are the after school activities on offer this year. If your child is in the appropriate age category and would like to do any of the clubs please complete the on-line form using the link below by <u>Wednesday 21st</u> <u>September</u>, ready to start week commencing Monday 26th September. Please note that Mrs Manners will communicate with parents to confirm attendance at the club.

After School Clubs

Whenever there are insufficient places for every pupil wishing to join a particular club, priority will be given to the eldest pupils or a rota will be organised. Otherwise places are allocated on a first come first served basis. Where clubs operate a rota then your child will only attend for the period of time allocated. Children may be able to do two clubs at different times of the year, so put both clubs on the reply slip if your child would like to do both. For example children may attend football club all year, but stop football in order to do 6 weeks of cookery.

On-line forms returned after a club register is full will be put on a waiting list.

After school clubs finish promptly at <u>4.20pm</u>, other than cookery which finishes at 4.30pm. If you are unable to collect your child at this time then please do not sign them up for a club. Pupils may depart school after a club on the junior playground, eg football in their sports kit direct from the playground, providing a parent/carer is visible to collect them. All other clubs will depart via the main entrance and parents should wait on the KS1slope.
