In Phonics, we will be reading and writing words reviewing all our learning:

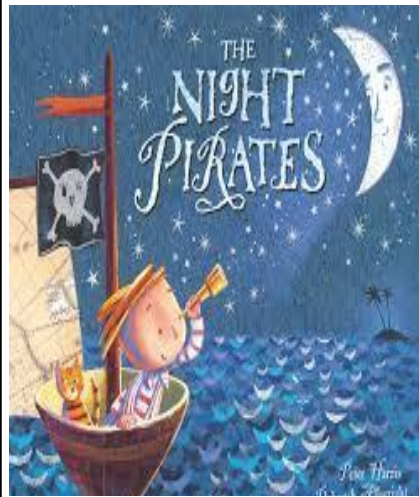
Balloon, presses, spears, crowds, floats, crunches, screeches, frighten, crowded, appear, portrait, morning. We will be writing sentences incorporating our 'tricky' words such as 'There is a chimpanzee crunching on a carrot.'

Week beginning 6.7.26

What we are learning:

As we begin our second pirate week, we will be sharing the story of 'Night pirates.' We will be re-enacting the story and thinking of our own ways to disguise a pirate ship. We will be learning about Pirate names, famous pirates and 'pirate talk.'

In maths, we will be counting treasure in 2s, 5s and 10s and using counting on and counting back to solve problems of addition and subtraction. We will be making our own treasure maps, adding features, and consolidating number bonds to 10.
