

This week in Reception

Phonics:

We will segment the sounds in words and write words such as rain, moan, sheep, night, turn, born and digger. We will continue to read and write words ending in '-ing' such as swimming, bumping, snapping, squelching; words ending in 'ed' such as stamped, bumped, helped, smashed and blinked; and words ending in 'est' such as plumpest, strongest and swiftest. We will use these words in our sentence writing eg He bumped his leg when he was swimming, she stamped her foot on the chair. We will revisit all phase 4 'tricky' words (see below).

What we are learning:

In Literacy, we are learning to retell the story of Oliver's vegetables and write our own versions of the story using some story language. We be focusing on talking about what we have heard and understood and using full sentences.

In Maths, we will be building on understanding of numbers and their order, looking for mistakes and explaining reasons. We will be focusing on the composition of numbers. We will be consolidating double and half of a number. We will be counting on and back from a number and using counting on and back to solve problems of addition and subtraction.

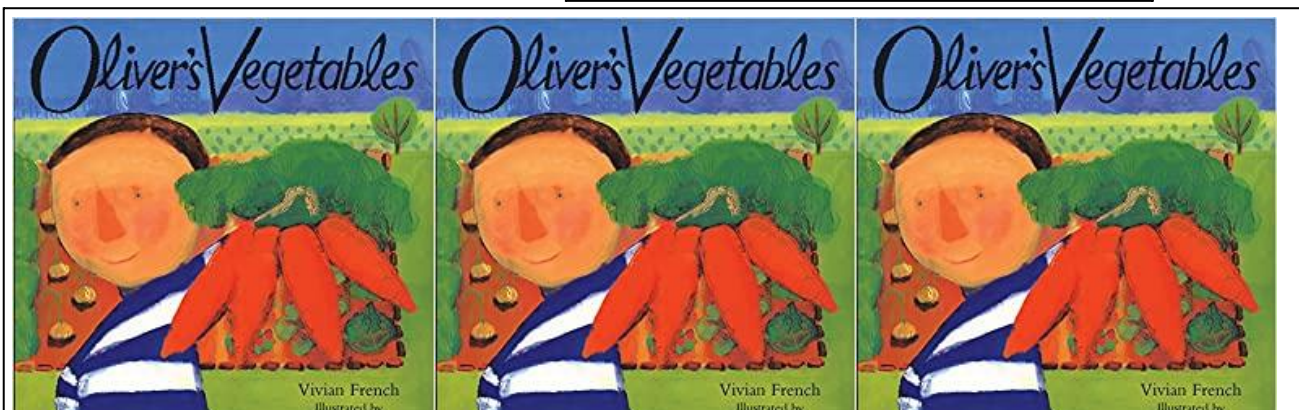
Home Learning
