Maths

- Finding the place value of two-digit numbers (partitioning into 10s and 1s).
- · Counting forward/backward in jumps of 10.
- · Ordering and comparing numbers, using < >.
- Knowing pairs of numbers to 10 & 20 and using these to answer other + or sums.
- · Reading & writing numbers to 100 in words/digits
- Adding and subtracting numbers by being able to count on/back in tens and ones.
- Telling the time to o'clock & half past, and introducing quarter past.
- · Naming common 2D and 3D shapes.
- · Recognising and using coins up to £2.
- · Measuring length in centimetres.
- Using left/right, clockwise & anti-clockwise.

Art and Design Technology

- · Creating Cityscapes and Landscapes.
- · Illustrating the Great Fire of London and comparing art effects to do so.
- · Using a variety of media, including pencil crayon, felt tip, charcoal, pastels, poster paint, marbling ink, watercolours, collage & digital media.
- Studying and appreciating the work of Van Gogh, Monet & Seurat

History/Geography

- Exploring where we live, the local area and its history, inc. local landmarks.
- Devising simple maps, planning routes, understanding aerial views, atlas skills (UK & the World), suggesting changes to our local area.
- Comparing local and international locations, customs and climates.

- · Sorting and classifying objects.
