


"To act justly, love mercy and walk humbly with your God" Micah 6:8

Our child friendly friendly vision statement stems directly from the biblical root. This underpins everything that we do as a school:

Ofsted - October 2018

Queniborough CE Primary School was last inspected in October 2018 and declared to be a 'good' school. Highlights from the report include:

History of Queniborough CE Primary School



Queniborough is a Church of England primary school that was founded in 1847. They gained 'Academy' status in November 2012.

The original National School building is in the village centre and now houses the swimming pool. The present school was built between 1953 and 1966, in four major phases and has been developed and improved constantly over recent years.

It currently has seven classrooms, an attractive hall, a kitchen, a computer suite, a cookery area, a staffroom and school offices. There are also several small areas for individual and small group work.

Outside there are two tarmac playgrounds, an attractive variety of flowerbeds and trees, a good sized playing field, a forest school area, a daily mile track, an extensive trim trail and some fabulous fitness equipment. Pupils also have access to the adjacent King George V Field.

We aim to be a family where all members of the school community feel inspired, listened to and value their achievements. We strongly believe in the education of the 'whole child' and are constantly looking for innovative ways to make the curriculum exciting for our pupils. The school is closely linked with St Mary's Church in the village and we have embedded the concern and caring attributes based on our Christian ethos in school. We value all areas of learning and human achievement.







Admissions

Queniborough CE Primary School is a thriving and popular school serving the village where it is based. Our catchment area can be viewed below and on our website but we also welcome applications from outside this area. We operate a single time admission for all children joining us at Foundation Stage. At the age of eleven, many of our pupils transfer to Wreake Valley Academy.

Parents and carers need to apply for a place at our school via the local authority by mid-January and places are confirmed in April. It is important to apply on time to have the best chance of securing a place at your preferred school.

SIAMS

All Church of England schools recieve an additional inspection as well as being inspected by OFSTED. Our last 'Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools'was in May 2016 when the school was given an 'Outstanding' rating. Some comments from the report:

• The depth of the school's Christian character enriches the lives of pupils and staff alike so that they all feel valued, supported and inspired to be the best that they can be.

The school's Christian values are deeply embedded in all aspects of school life and all members of the school community consistently talk about the impact that each value has on their daily lives.

Our Curriculum

We want children to become independent, determined and effective learners. We do everything possible to ensure that our children become life-long learners and to pursue their learning out of school.

We believe that pupils need to have fluency in their reading, writing and maths skills. To ensure this is achieved, pupils will have daily Reading, Writing and Maths lessons. This starts in the EYFS, where children will learn phonics. Children will also receive a weekly lesson of RE, Computing, PSHE, Music, MFL and PE.

Other foundation subjects (Science, Geography, History, Art & Design, Design & Technology) are blocked over the half-term. This reduces the cognitive load on pupils so that they have less subject knowledge to remember each week.

To support the implementation of the National Curriculum, we have adopted the CUSP curriculum for a number of our subjects. Other subjects also have links to published curricula, which we have evaluated to ensure they are of high quality. By using these resources, we have been able to carefully construct component knowledge so that it is planned sequentially. This enables pupils to build on prior learning and have opportunity to retrieve prior knowledge regularly so that learning is not lost.



We have more to offer

Whilst we have an excellent core curriculum, we also believe strongly in preparing children for life, with a range of experiences as part of the wider curriculum including families and the community as much as possible.

Performing Arts

Children have the opportunity take part in a variety of drama productions throughout their life at Queniborough School.

Our youngest children perform a nativity play as part of our Christmas celebrations.

Music

Peripatetic instrumental teachers visit the school each week. We employ guitar and piano teachers.

Currently all children in our 4 class are learning to play the ukulele! Our school choir also takes part in a variety of community and city events.

Sports

We have school teams, clubs and groups in many sports. We take part in all the local, area and County football, netball, swimming, badminton, tri-golf, cross country running, athletics tournaments and galas and have been very successful in recent years. Coaches from local sports clubs often work with us in school.

Additional Skills

During each year, our children work for a variety of charities, local, national and international. This helps us to raise their awareness of global, environmental, social, moral and medical issues.

Recently we have supported BBC Children in Need, The Rainbows Children's Hospice, LOROS The Royal British Legion, Comic Relief and Save the Children.

Tree House Before and After School Club

Queniborough CE Primary School Tree House provides safe and secure care for children aged four to eleven, before and after school.

Tree House is open for breakfast from 7:30am—8:40am and for after school care from 3:20pm —5:30pm (3:20pm - 5pm on Fridays) – term time only.

Tree House is run by a team of well trained and experienced staff that provides a variety of activities for children. These activities include:- games, art & craft, homework group, IT activities, a reading area for children to share stories, read by themselves or read with a leader, cooking and Sport.

A variety of special events such as movie nights, Christmas parties and Easter egg hunts are also held throughout the year.
