Learning Together to Enjoy and Achieve

English: As part of our new History topic this term, we will follow the story of 'The Golden Horsemen' of Baghdad'. This will give the children opportunities to further extend both their reading and writing skills with a focus on both the quality and quantity of their work. We will also continue to consolidate a good understanding of their spelling, punctuation and grammar learning.

<u>Maths</u>: In Maths, we will be completing our learning on fractions, decimals and percentages before moving onto some learning about perimeter and area. We will then explore the world of statistics looking at different graphs and charts, including pie charts.

Science: The topic we will be exploring this term is Electricity. We will learn how to use circuit symbols as a way to record the circuits we create. We will also investigate the effect of changing the volts on different components within a circuit.

<u>History:</u> This term we will be learning about the Early Islamic Civilisation with a particular focus on Baghdad. We will discover more about this fascinating culture with a particular focus on the House of Wisdom, and the contributions that were made to modern thinking.

<u>PSHE</u>

We will begin by thinking about how we can make a difference to others before we focus on 'Healthy Me'. We will explore different ways to take responsibility for our wellbeing, emotional and mental health.

<u>Art</u>:

We will begin our study of perspective and will also look at some of the work of the artist LS Lowry.

<u>RE</u>:

This term, we will be exploring the importance of architecture and art to different religions and thinking about its place in modern life.

<u>Spanish</u>:

We will learn to talk about our daily routine and tell the time in Spanish. We will also learn nouns for funfair rides and create extended sentences.

Computing:

The children will be introduced to creating a data set in a spreadsheet. They will use these spreadsheets to plan an event and answer questions before evaluating their results.

P.E. and Games:

These sessions will be on Mondays and Thursdays this term. In the hall, we will explore the skills to play badminton. Outside, we will develop ball skills to include accurate throwing, catching and fielding to enable us play the game of longball.

Please ensure that your child has appropriate indoor and outdoor PE kit in school at all times.
