

SUMMARY OF SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN 2023 - 2024

THE QUALITY OF EDUCATION SUMMARY

Key Objective 1: To create a bespoke and knowledge-rich curriculum which enables teachers to identify pupils' learning gaps and help all children to make rapid progress so that the *number of pupils meeting Age Related Expectations and Greater Depth in each year group are consistently above National Averages in core subjects in Key Stage 1 and 2*. Specific focus on groups of children who are consistently working towards ARE with no identified SEN.

Key areas to improve:

- 1.1 To sustain and build on the good practice in place in implementing the Systematic Synthetic Phonics (SSP) programme – Phonics Shed
- 1.2 To sustain and build on the good practice in place in Reading, Writing and Maths ensuring high expectations for all children
- 1.3 To further embed the enquiry curriculum to ensure a knowledge-rich progressive curriculum in which teachers planning and strategies provide inclusive teaching with high expectations for all pupils
- 1.4 To ensure assessment and moderation practices support teachers and LSAs in identifying pupils' learning gaps so they can plan strategically and teach effectively
- 1.5 To ensure Early Years practices in place support the specific needs of the new cohort

BEHAVIOUR AND ATTITUDES SUMMARY

Key Objective 2: To ensure pupils behave with high levels of respect for others in their school, community and the wider world making them good British citizens

Key areas to improve:

- 2.1 Embed a consistent approach to promoting and supporting positive behaviour
- 2.2 Develop children's understanding and ability to engage in a range of play activities harmoniously for a sustained period learning how to problem solve and use conflict-resolution strategies to find enjoyment within new experiences
- 2.3 To embed children's language for learning and ensure metacognitive and long-term memory practices are in place to support children in making good progress. Particular focus to support Working Towards pupils based on EEF research findings
- 2.4 Increase whole school attendance to 96%+
- 2.5 Consider strategies to strengthen parent/carers understanding of their role in managing e-safety/ online behaviour at home

PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT SUMMARY

Key Objective 3: To improve the consistency and quality in the promotion of personal development in all aspects of school life

Key areas to improve:

- 3.1 To embed the school vision statement
- 3.2 Promote diversity, inclusion and pupils' understanding of the protected characteristics
- 3.3 To further embed strategies and approaches to ensure high-quality experiences in personal development for positive health and wellbeing to support all pupils

LEADERSHIP AND MANAGEMENT SUMMARY

Key Objective 4: To ensure leadership and management are effective so that staff are well-supported so that high expectations of all pupils are realised

Key areas to improve:

- 4.1 To ensure strong safeguarding leadership remains effective
- 4.2 To adapt current practices and systems to improve workload and wellbeing of staff
- 4.3 To develop the new Designated Teacher lead and SENDco lead to provide good quality provision for SEND, LAC and PLAC, parents/carers and staff
- 4.4 To further develop the knowledge and skills of middle leaders to effectively analyse and develop their subjects to improve outcomes for pupils and quality of teaching
- 4.5 To further embed pupil leadership and develop positive experiences for all pupils as leaders
