Learning Together to Enjoy and Achieve

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

This term we will be learning about how we can help others and how others can help us. We will be learning about how to look after our teeth and bodies and also how we can self-regulate our emotions and manage our feelings.

Communication and Language:

We will be continuing to work on our speaking and listening skills. We will work on speaking in small groups and to the class to share news. We will also ask questions to visitors.

Literacy:

We will be reading non-fiction books about different occupations as well as stories such as 'Supertato', 'Superhero like you', 'Polar Bear, Polar Bear', and 'Mog and the V.E.T.'. We will also be writing questions, thank you letters, writing about stories and facts about different jobs.

Mathematics:

We will continue our daily 'Mastery Number' lessons where our focus will be on 'wholes' and 'parts' and the composition of numbers to 5. We will also be comparing numbers to 5, working on composition of 6,7,8, combining two groups, mass and capacity and finally length and height.

Physical Development:

This term we will complete weekly gymnastic lessons where we will focus on making body shapes, travelling in different ways, mat, bench and partner work. There will also be daily opportunities to develop our gross and fine motor skills through our 'Root Learning' sessions, both inside and outside.

Expressive Arts and Design:

We will be creating props and resources for different job roles. We will also be learning a 'superhero dance'. We will use media such as painting, collage, drawing and model making to create representations of different objects. We will also be creating lanterns for our 'Lunar New Year' learning.

Understanding The World:

We will be learning about different occupations and roles. We will have some visitors to share with us what their jobs entail. We will also be looking at 'Winter' and comparing the polar regions to the UK. We will learn about 'Lunar New Year'. Finally, in R.E we will be learning about why people are special.
