Curriculum Overview

Learning Together to Enjoy and Achieve

English and Reading

This term we will be exploring why people migrate. We will be using these reasons to inspire a range of different writing, including non-chronological reports, poetry and narratives. We will be reading a sequel to the Hotel Flamingo called Holiday Heatwave and using our VIPERS skills to answer questions about the text.

Maths

This term we start by recapping our knowledge of money and coins and think about how to add money and give change. We will also recap and build on our learning about shape and will investigate statistics, interpreting, representing and collecting data using pictograms and bar charts.

<u>Science</u>

Our topic is Light. We will clarify sources of light and how darkness is the absence of light. We will explore how light is reflected and how shadows are formed and change throughout the day.

Computing

The children will explore links between events and actions, while consolidating prior learning relating to sequencing.

Spanish:

We are learning picnic food and drink nouns, and how to politely and accurately ask and answer requests. We will also be exploring the culture of Spain, and learning how to ask and answer questions. about where we live.

Geography

We will be comparing Spain and the United Kingdom, exploring the similarities and difference of their physical and human features, weather and culture.

RE

We will be considering the question 'Why is the Bible important to Christians?' This will explore connections between the Bible and what Christians believe about creation.

<u>PSHE</u>

This term's unit is 'Changing me'. We will learn about how babies grow as well as changes in our bodies. We will also think about transition and what we are looking forward to in Year 4.

<u>Music</u>

We will be listening to and appraising different types of Spanish music, linked to our Geography learning.

PE

We will be practicing cricket skills this term. We will also start to work on our athletics skills in preparation for our sports day later in the term. Our PE days are **Wednesdays** and **Fridays**.

<u>Art</u>

Linked to our Geography, we will be focusing on the abstract art by a Spanish artist, Joan Miro and an English artist, Mary Webb.
