The Victorians

English

In the first half term, we will be writing 'twisted tales' which will involve children writing from the perspective of a fairy-tale villain. Their focus will be to include direct speech to enhance the action.



In the second half term, we will be writing a newspaper report based around workhouses in Victorian Britain.

Maths



This term, your child will be learning about and working with: decimals, negative numbers, position and direction, transforming shape, converting units of measure and measuring volume. We will also be

working towards filling any gaps in their knowledge.

History



In History, we will investigate the Victorian era by comparing and contrasting rich/poor lifestyles. We will also be looking at the differences and similarities between modern technology and Victorian inventions

Guided Reading

In Guided Reading this term, we will be exploring 'Street Child' by Berlie Doherty. Whilst linking to our history theme, this text will allow children to develop their reading skills and historical knowledge.



Science

Children will be taught to describe the differences in the life cycles of mammals, amphibians, insects and birds. They will describe the life process of reproduction in plants and Animals, as well as describing the changes in human development to old age. As part of this topic, children will learn about puberty: the physical changes that occur for boys and girls during puberty and how this might affect emotions and feelings. <u>Art and Design</u> Children will experiment with different types of art, craft and design with a focus on William Morris.

Design & Technology

This term, children will design, create and evaluate their own puppets based on a Victorian circus.



Music

This term, we will be learning about the renowned composer and performer Florence Price. She was one of the first ground-breaking female, black artists.

Computing

The children will have the opportunity to create virtual 3D models during their computing lessons this term.



Physical Education During PE, the children will learn different techniques and develop a range of skills. They will use this to improve and evaluate their performance in athletics.
