Intent

Our music curriculum aims to provide students with a high-quality music education which engages and inspires them to develop a life-long love of music, increases their self confidence, creativity and imagination and provides opportunities for self-expression and a sense of personal achievement. Children participate in a wide range of activities to develop their talents in all aspects of music including rhythm work, instrumental skills, composition, singing and appreciation.



What?

Music is taught for an hour each week, following the Leicestershire Music curriculum.

Year 4 children are provided with the opportunity to learn a musical instrument through weekly whole class teaching.

Opportunities to sing and perform are provided across each year group, for example Nativity play and Year 6 performance.

Impact

- Children receive teaching and an opportunity to develop their talents across all aspects of music, with progression through each year group.

- Children learn an instrument developing musicianship skills, encouraging team working and providing a sense of achievement.

- Children develop confidence to perform in front of an audience, supporting the development of self-esteem and a sense of achievement.
