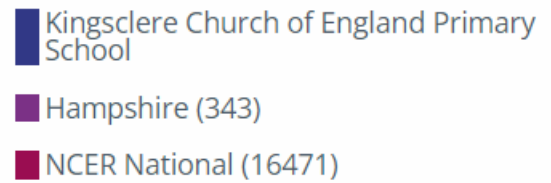


Kingsclere CE Primary School Year 6

Please note that because of COVID-19, statutory national assessments were cancelled in 2020 and 2021.

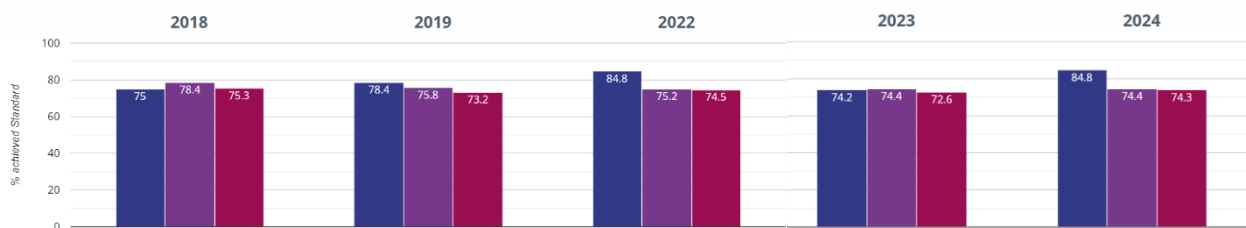
The bar charts below show results for children in Year 6 at the end of Key Stage 2 in Reading, Writing, Maths (RWM), Combined RWM and Science. There were 33 children in Year 6 in 2024 - 15 boys and 18 girls.



Reading Year 6 – End of Key Stage 2 – 2018 to 2024

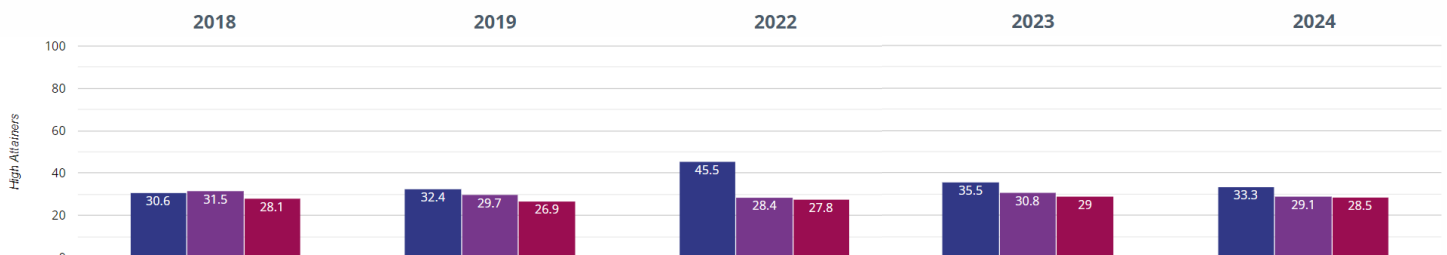
In 2024, 84.8% of our Kingsclere CE Primary School Year 6 children achieved the expected standard (EXS) in Reading which is above National and Hampshire averages.

Reading - achieved standard



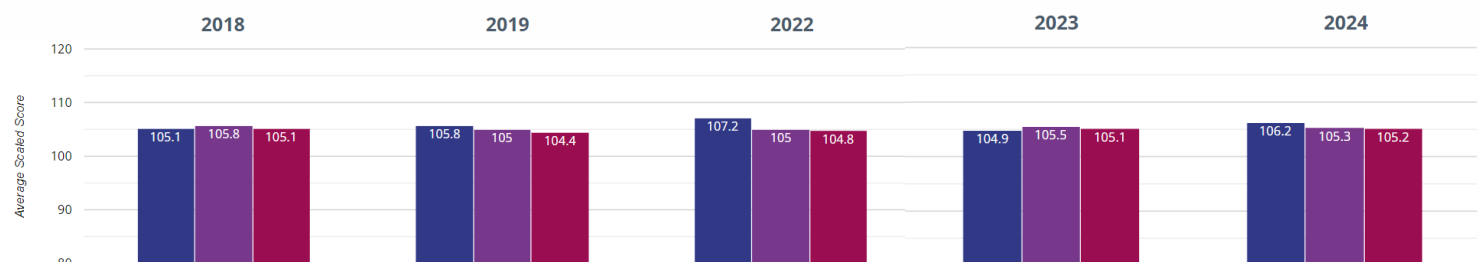
In 2024, 33.3% of our Year 6 children achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Reading. This GDS attainment places us above National and Hampshire averages.

Reading - high attainers



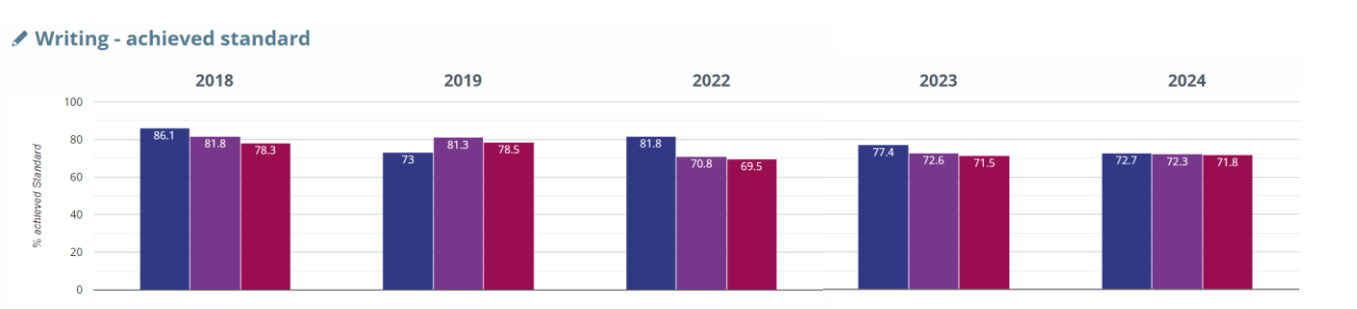
Our Reading scaled scores, in 2024, are also above National and Hampshire averages.

Reading - average scaled score

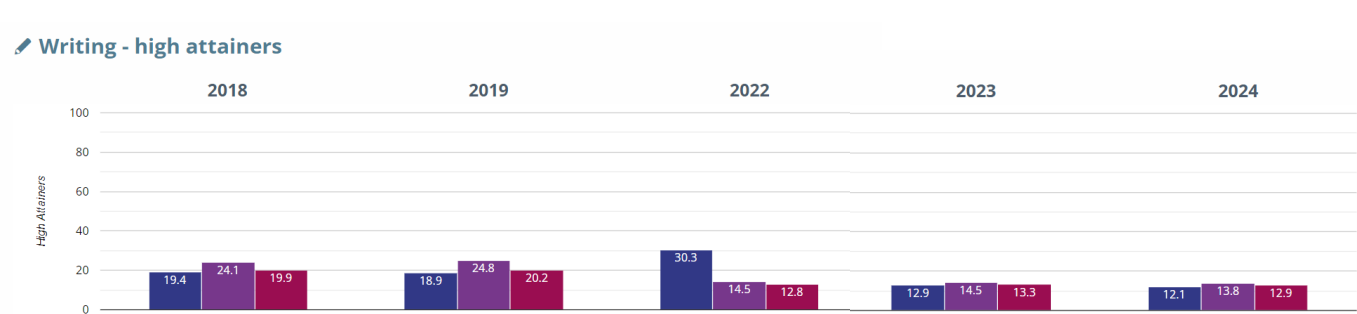


Writing – Year 6 – End of Key Stage 2 – 2018 - 2024

72.7% of our Year 6 children achieved the expected standard in Writing in 2024. This years' percentage scores are above the National and Hampshire averages.

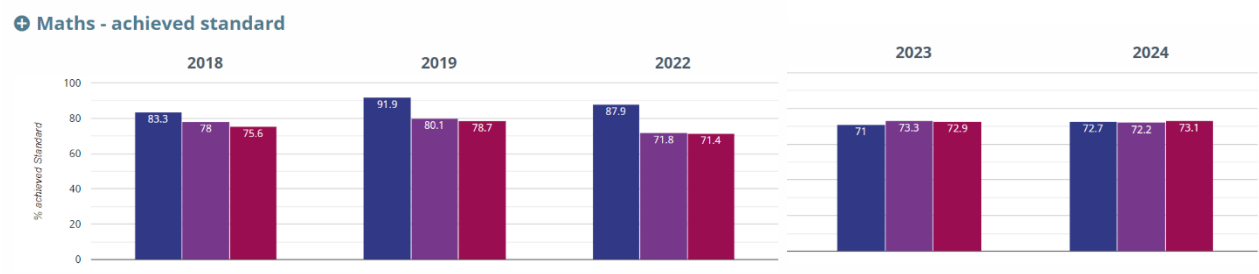


12.1% of our Year 6 children achieved Greater Depth Standards (GDS) in writing in 2024 which is closely in line with National and Hampshire averages.

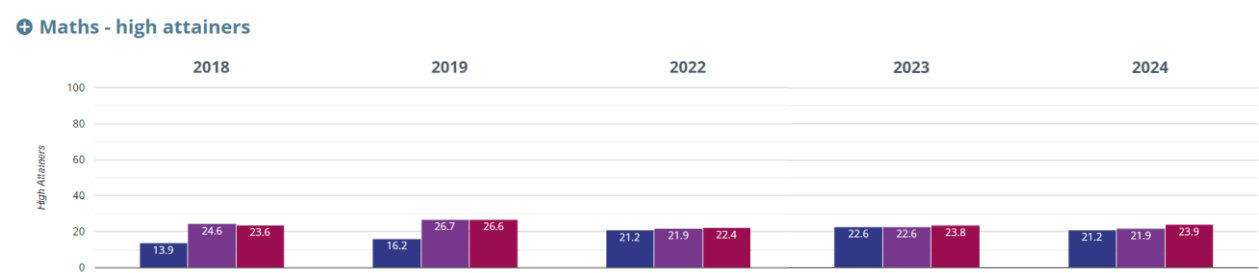


Maths – Year 6 – End of Key Stage 2 – 2018 - 2024

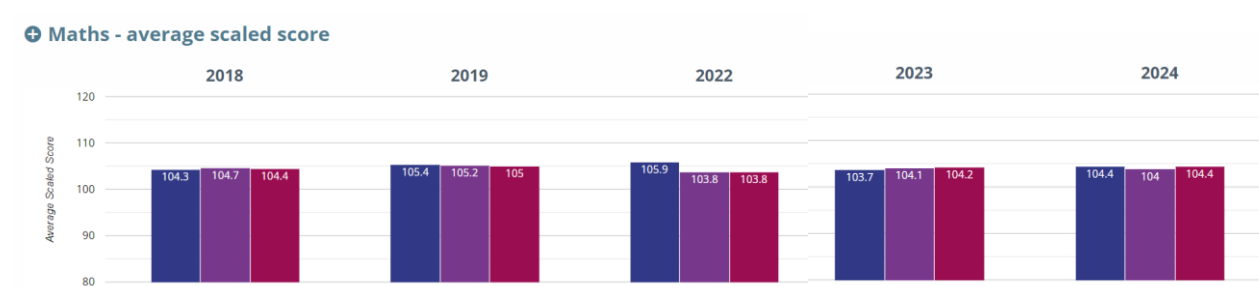
In 2024, 72.7% of our Year 6 children achieved the expected standard in Maths which is above National and Hampshire averages.



Our Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Maths in 2024 was close to National and Hampshire averages.

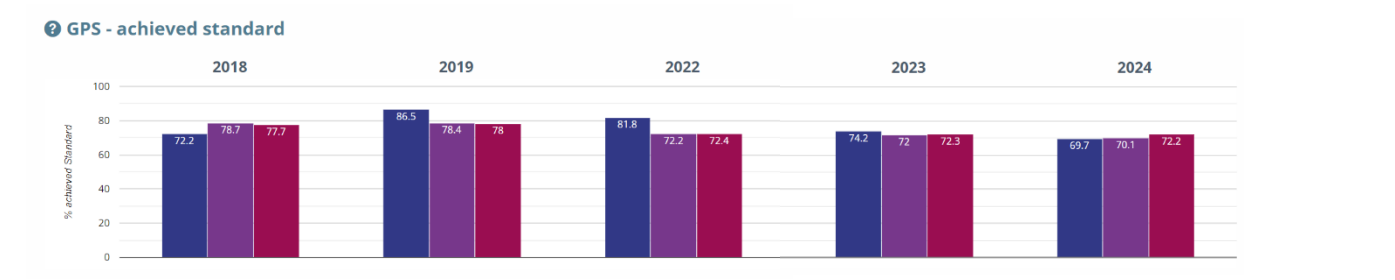


Our Maths scaled scores are in line with National and Hampshire averages in 2024.

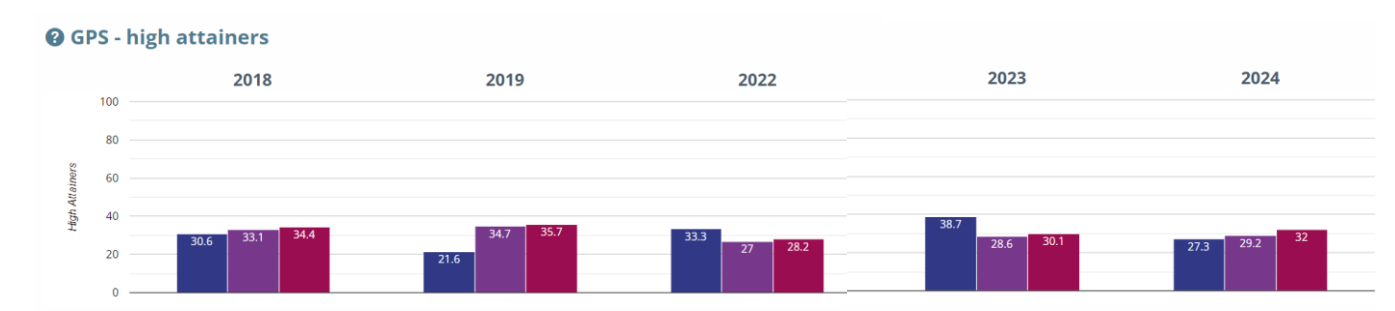


Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling – Year 6 – End of Key Stage 2 – 2018 - 2024

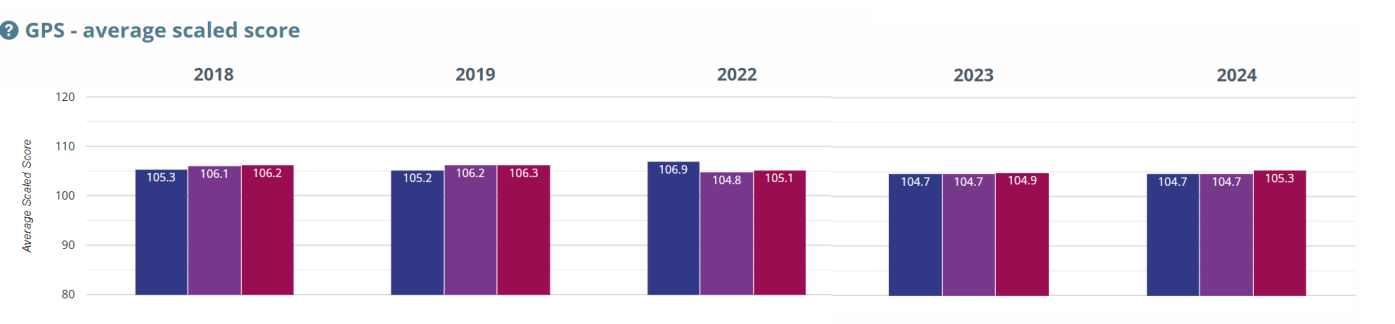
69.7% of children achieved the expected standards in 2024 which is closely in line with National and Hampshire standards.



27.3% of our Year 6 children achieved Greater Depth standards in 2024 which was slightly below National and Hampshire standards.

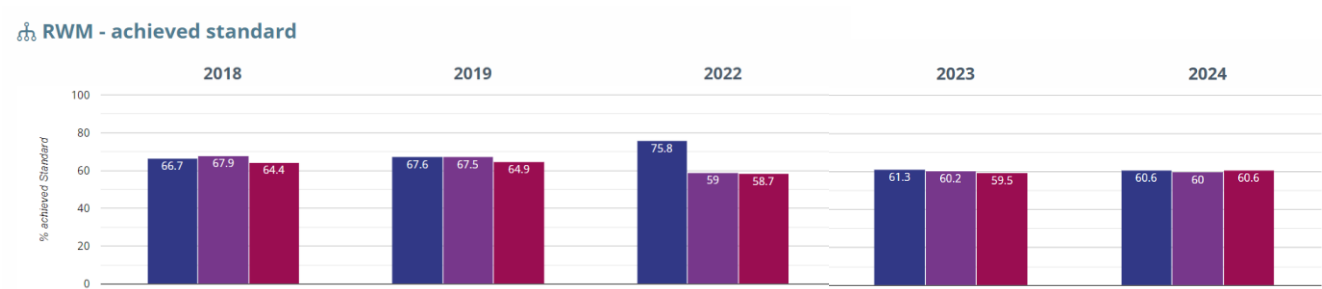


The average scaled score for children in Year 6 in 2024 in Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling was the same as Hampshire standards and close to the National average.

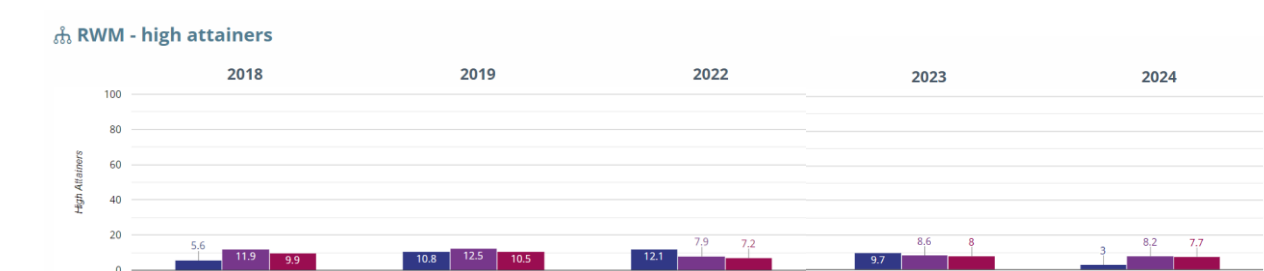


Combined results (Reading, Writing and Maths) in Year 6 – 2018 - 2024

In 2024, 60.6% of children in Year 6 achieved the Expected Standard (EXS) in Reading, Writing and Mathematics which was in line with both the National and Hampshire averages.



The number of children achieving combined Greater Depth in 2024 is 3% and below National and Hampshire averages.



Science – Year 6 – End of Key Stage 2

In 2024, 73% of our Year 6 children achieved the expected standard in Science.
