#### Forest School

Can we remind you the children will be outdoors for each Forest School session this term and must bring the following clothing to change into at school:

Long sleeved top, full length trousers, wellies/sturdy shoes or boots. Clothes are likely to become wet/dirty, so please don't send anything you don't want to get soiled.

Other recommended items: sun cream and sun hat for hot weather, waterproofs, gloves, hat, scarf and warm clothing for colder weather. (Please write your child's name in all clothing.) The children will need to ensure they have a water bottle to take with them.

### Extended School

Please be aware that Breakfast Club and After School Club are now full and Extended School are unable to take adhoc bookings. They do have a waiting list for anyone requiring wrap around care in the future. Can we please take this opportunity to remind you that a terms notice is required if you are needing to change or withdraw your child's place at Breakfast or After School Club. Drop off and pick up for Extended Schools is via the Visitor carpark at the front of the school. Entry and exit is monitored via the intercom system (button) located on the wall by the small blue metal gate. Thank you.

# End of Day Permissions

If your child/ren are now in Years 4, 5 or 6, please complete the forms below regarding end of day permissions. With parental consent, children are able to leave their classroom and meet you at an agreed point (Years 4, 5 and 6) or leave the school grounds (Years 5 & 6 only) at the end of the school day. If permission has not been granted, your child will not be allowed to leave the classroom unaccompanied at the end of the school day. Please be aware if you do not wish for your child to leave their classroom, you still have to make a selection on the form.
