

North America

English

In English this half term, we will be writing a set of instructions linked to our DT focus. Additionally, we will be writing diary entries from the perspective of the main protagonist of our class novel, Windrush Child. During the second half term, we will write a biography and spend some time looking at poetry.

Maths



This term we will continue exploring fractions, multiplication and division. We will also be starting statistics, area and perimeter.

Reading

This term, we will be reading Windrush child by Benjamin Zephaniah. It explores the history of the Windrush generation and will be even more poignant to study this year after the sad passing of the author in December 2023.



Geography



We will go on a journey around North America. Visiting the Caribbean, Mexico, United States of America and Canada. We will touch on natural features and disasters (including volcanoes).

Science

For our Science we will be investigating Earth and Space. We will describe the movement of the Earth and Moon, compare the size of planets and explain how day and night occur. Using computers to extend our knowledge and examine the night sky.



Art and Design

We will be exploring the works of Frida Khalo and creating self portraits in her style.

Design & Technology
