## End of Day Permissions - September 2024

If your child/ren will be in years 4, 5 or 6 in September 2024, please complete the forms below regarding end of day permissions. With parental consent, children are able to leave their classroom and meet you at an agreed point (years 4, 5 and 6) or leave the school grounds (years 5 & 6 only) at the end of the school day. This will be effective from September. If this form has not been completed or permission has not been granted, your child will not be allowed to leave the classroom unaccompanied at the end of the school day.

### Year 3 September - School Lunches

If your child will be starting in Year 3 in September can we please remind you that you will need to register an account with CH&Co, our lunch provider, if your child will be having a cooked school meal. Please follow this link to set up your account. You will need to register an account regardless of if you pay for your child's meals or they are eligible for free school meals. If you are unsure if you are eligible for free school meals, or need to register, please follow this link. It takes roughly 2 minutes to apply and you just need your National Insurance number. You will be informed immediately if you qualify. If you have any further questions, or you would like the school to confidentially apply on your behalf, please do not hesitate to contact the School Office. Can we take this opportunity to remind that you that if your child is eligible for free school meals they are also eligible for Pupil Premium Funding. This funding is used for extra staff to support your child, extra opportunities for them to access a wider curriculum and resources to support and enhance their learning. This would make a drastic difference to our budget. If this extra funding went unclaimed, it could result in a missed opportunity for your child to receive the very best experiences at school that we can offer.
