WHAT DO WE NEED TO KNOW? HOW CAN WE LEARN THIS? WHO CAN WE LEARN FROM?

PSHE: Changing Me: Our bodies, healthy eating, how we have changed, overcoming worries of moving to year one and memories.

Physical Development: Gymnastics unit – focusing on balancing and moving in different ways.

Literacy: We will be reading Harry and the bucketful of dinosaurs' and 'Captain Flynn and the Pirate Dinosaurs', 'Rainbow Fish'. We will be reading non-fiction texts about dinosaurs and creating our own fact files. We will be describing dinosaurs to make wanted posters and writing ingredients and instructions to make dinosaur biscuits. Also, we will be writing our own dinosaur adventures. Maths: Counting beyond 10 and 20, number patterns, comparison, odds and evens, recall and explaining. Doubling or halving numbers. Recalling number bonds to 5 and 10. Measuring and weighing dinosaurs.

Understanding the World: Talking about, sorting and classifying what dinosaurs eat. Carrying out volcano experiments. Carrying out excavations and putting together dinosaur bones.

Expressive Arts and Design: Using textures to create a volcano. Junk modelling a 3D dinosaur. Using different materials to create a skeleton.


