Learning Together to Enjoy and Achieve

<u>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</u>: This term we will be learning about how we can be 'Resourceful'. We will be linking this to our school values of 'resourcefulness' and 'collaboration' and will be thinking about how we can work together to solve problems and create learning opportunities.

<u>Communication and Language</u>: We will be continuing to work on our speaking and listening skills. We will also be learning new vocabulary linked to our topic and exploring what new words mean.

<u>Literacy:</u> We will be reading the books: 'Dear Zoo', 'Rumble in the Jungle', 'Naughty Bus', 'Train Ride' and 'View at the Zoo'. We will also be writing instructions, labelling animals and writing recounts linked to our learning.

<u>Mathematics</u>: We will continue our daily 'Mastery Number' lessons where our focus will be on 'Comparing numbers'. In our other Maths lessons, we will be working with numbers beyond 10, addition, taking away and spatial reasoning.

<u>Physical Development:</u> This term we will completing weekly PE lessons where we will focus on using small equipment such as balls and beanbags to throw, catch, roll, hit and balance. We will also have opportunities to climb on large equipment, ride balance bikes and use the outdoor environment. We will also be developing our fine motor skills by threading, weaving, drawing, painting, cutting and joining materials.

Expressive Arts and Design:

This term we will be using recycled resources to create vehicles and containers. We will also be creating artwork for our Jungle display. In addition to this, we will have the opportunity to create lots of artwork using paint and collage materials.

Understanding the World:

We will be learning about animal names, their young and habitats. We will be using globes and maps to find out where different animals live. Finally, in RE we will be looking at the Bible story of Noah and the Ark. We will also begin to plant some seeds in preparation for our topic in Term 6.
