Learning Together to Enjoy and Achieve

English: We will begin the term focusing on non-fiction writing based around our Great Fire of London topic. The children will travel back in time and imagine what it would have been like in 1666 through drama activities. We will then be writing a non-fiction book about the event. The children will continue to have daily Guided Reading lessons, during which we will focus on developing both decoding and comprehension skills.

Maths: This term we will continue to embed strategies for addition and subtraction, as well as consolidating place value. Mastering Number will be taught for the development of number fluency. Later in the term, we will be exploring 2D and 3D shapes where we will be considering their properties, lines of symmetry and shapes within patterns.

Science: This term we will be learning about humans, including stages of development, healthy eating and exercise. We will also be classifying animals and developing an understanding of what humans need to survive.

Humanities: Our History topic of the Great Fire of London is being explored through English. We will consider the chronology of the events in 1666 when, in history, the fire took place and investigate what happened and how it affected London and the residents.

Music:

This term, the children will be exploring beat and rhythm. We will also be practising Christmas songs in the lead up to our Christmas production.

PSHE:

This term, our topic is 'Celebrating Difference'. We will be discussing stereotypes, celebrating our differences and exploring bullying. We will learn what bullying is as well as supporting Anti-Bullying Week.

Art & DT:

Our Art this term is linked to the Great Fire of London, creating collages, sketching and marbling. In DT, we will be making 3D Tudor Stuart houses.

PE:

We will be developing key football skills in our outdoor session. In the hall we will be taking part in circuit training activities.

RE:

We will be considering our key question: What can we learn from sacred books?

Computing

The children will learn to recognise that different devices can be used to capture photographs and will gain experience capturing, editing and improving photos.
