## Allergy Awareness Week

Did you know that this week is Allergy Awareness Week? Allergies affect 1 in 10 children, whether that be a food allergy such as nuts, soya or celery or pollen. Earlier this academic year, we were very lucky to have a staff awareness session delivered by Claire Bristow, founder of the Sadie Bristow Foundation. Claire's aim is to continue Sadie's legacy by supporting children and their families who live with allergies and conditions such as asthma. We learned lots of interesting and vitally important information about allergies and anaphylaxis which could be lifesaving. As you are aware, we are a nut free school so that we can strive to ensure our pupils and staff with allergies such as this are in a safe environment to learn and work.





In addition to this, we have also invested in additional adrenaline pens for school which are stored in our new safety box in the hall so that we can help a member of our community should they have an anaphylactic reaction.
