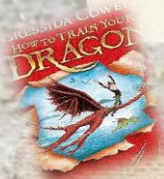


OXLEY PRIMARY SCHOOL

English

In English, we are continuing with our novel study on 'How to Train Your Dragon,' by Cressida Cowell. The children have really enjoyed this book so far and they have already produced some super work. This half term, we will be working on setting descriptions, recapping our work on speech and writing our own narratives in the same style as the author.

French

In French, we will be starting our new unit, 'En Classe,' where we will be learning the vocabulary for different items found within the classroom including those found in a typical pencil case.

Art

Our art unit this term will concentrate on how to make our drawings come to life by using animation. We will be using computer software to help us to make our drawings move.



Science

This term in Science, we will be learning about the digestive system including teeth. We will look at how our teeth help us to begin the digestive process and what happens as the food moves through our bodies. We will also investigate food chains and what happens when the environment around an animal changes.

Maths



This half term, we will begin our unit on time where we will learn to tell the time to the nearest minute on both an analogue and digital clock and complete work on years, months, days and duration. After, we will move on to study shape; learning about different turns and angles, in addition to learning about parallel and perpendicular lines and drawing and making shapes. Our final maths unit will be on statistics where we will learn to draw and interpret different types of charts in addition to collecting and representing data on two-way tables.



PE

In PE on a Tuesday we will be working on our gymnastic skills as well as focusing on teamwork and collaboration. On a Thursday, we will be working on our throwing, hitting and fielding skills.

DT

Our DT unit this term will see us focussing on food technology where we will concentrate on bread. We will begin by researching a range of different breads and will conclude by making our very own bread products!

PSHE

In PSHE this term, we will be looking at relationships and sex education where we will discuss how male and female bodies are different and what different parts are called. We will also consider how bodies change and who our trusted adults are who can help us. We will go on to discuss personal hygiene and how to keep ourselves clean as well as how to prevent different illnesses and diseases from spreading.

Computing

Our final unit will focus on programming and using Scratch to modify and create animations using repetition. This will build on our work on LOGO previously.
