

Kingsclere CE Primary School Year 2 - End of Key Stage 1 SAT Results 2019, 2022 and 2023

The bar charts below show the results for children in Year 2 at the end of Key Stage 1 in Reading, Writing, Maths and Science. There were 33 children in Year 2 in 2023 - 16 boys and 17 girls.




Reading Year 2 - End of Key Stage 1 - 2019, 2022 and 2023

In 2023, 75.8% of our Kingsclere CE Primary School Year 2 children achieved the expected standard (EXS) in Reading which is above the national and Hampshire averages.




In 2023, 24.2% of our Year 2 children achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Reading. This GDS attainment places us above national and Hampshire averages.




Writing - Year 2 - End of Key Stage 1 - 2019, 2022 and 2023

63.6% of our Year 2 children achieved the expected standard in Writing in 2023. This year's percentage score is above the national average of 60.1%.




18.2% of our Year 2 children achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in writing, in 2023, above national and Hampshire averages.




Maths - Year 2 - End of Key Stage 1 - 2019, 2022 and 2023

In 2023, 72.7% of our Year 2 children achieved the expected standard in Maths. This was above national averages and close to Hampshire averages.




Our Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Maths was 12.1%. Our school improvement planning focus for 2023 - 2024 will be to achieve GDS scores at least in-line with national and Hampshire averages.




Science - Year 2 - End of Key Stage 1 - 2019, 2022 and 2023

In 2023, 78.8% of our Year 2 children achieved the expected standard in Science and this is in line with the national average of 78.7%.




Combined results (Reading, Writing and Mathematics) - 2019, 2022 and 2023

In 2023, 57.6% of children in Year 2 achieved the Expected Standard (EXS) in Reading, Writing and Mathematics which is above the national average of 56%. This shows an increase from our school's previous year combined results in 2019 and 2022.
