

# Art and Design

## Intent

Our art curriculum provides children with opportunities to develop their skills using a range of media and materials.

It has been planned to develop children's skills of drawing, painting, printing, collage, textiles and 3D work. Art work maybe linked to topic work or completed in stand alone lessons.

Art at Queniborough encourages all children to take risks and experiment with their own ideas as well as suggestions to them. Children are given opportunities explore and evaluate their different creative ideas.

Lessons will allow opportunities for children to be reflective when completing their work. They are encouraged to evaluate, change and improve their work.

Allow children to learn about the important work of artists and architects. All classes will learn about famous artists and will be encouraged to learn about art in the local community.

## What?

Art and design is taught weekly or lessons can be blocked. Art can be taught explicitly or as a cross curricular or themed lesson.

Each year group follows a teaching plan that ensures progression of skills and knowledge from Foundation Stage to Year 6.

Children have the opportunity to learn about a minimum of 3 different artists each year.

## Impact

- Children can use their creativity to express themselves through a range of media to create artwork linked to their topics, subjects and knowledge and skills they have learned.

- Teachers use ongoing assessment from art lessons to inform future lessons; ensuring children are supported and challenged appropriately when developing their skills.

- Children can talk confidently about a range of artists and their experiences in art and design.
