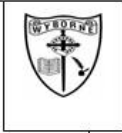

Lila and the Secret of Rain by David Conway

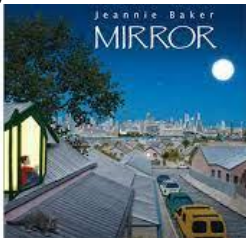

Division and multiplication

We are using the songs on the ministry of maths website (as mentioned on Weduc) to help with our times tables.

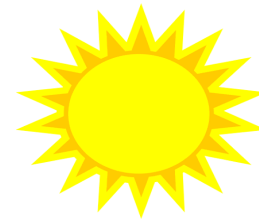
Phonics

We will continue to follow phonics play; looking at alternative spellings of familiar phonemes. We will begin to examine plurals. (Currently we are working at Phase 5c)

We will use Spelling Frame to extend and further consolidate the children's reading/writing and spelling.

Science / Geography

Weather – We will examine different types of weather across the seasons and in different parts of the world.



PE

Attack Defend Shoot - We will learn how to send and receive a ball using the feet/hands. We will work on skills such as dribbling, passing and partner work.

Hit Catch Run – We develop hitting skills with a variety of bats.

1C will continue to have PE sessions run by the coaches.

Art and Design

We will focus on drawing and painting, using different techniques such as light and shade, shadow, using different sized brushes, mixing colours of paint to create tones for effect.

We will also use clay to create an individual project.
