English:

Our English work will be inspired by D Day. We will be using the animation short: The Piano by Aidan Gibbons. The children will be using the work produced from this unit to show what they have learnt about creating impact on the reader through vocabulary and grammar choices.

Science: Our science focus for this half

term is: Sound

We will be gaining an understanding of the how the ear works and how we hear. The children will also be conducting experiments to make sound visible and to change sound.

History:

Through our enquiry this term, we will be developing children's understanding of what happened in the time leading up to D day, D day itself and how this changed the course of history. Our D day focus links to the 80th commemoration and will give us the opportunity to attend a memorial event, listen to first hand accounts and draw conclusions about this turning point in history.

Mathematics:

They will also be working on teams to design, plan, budget and present their Theme Park. There will be certificates awarded for the park that makes the most am profit! Year 5: Year 5 will be consolidating methods and applying this to problem solving ahead of Year 6. We will have a focus on methods and securing known facts.
