Learning Together to Enjoy and Achieve

English: We will start the term with researching and publishing an information leaflet all about The Crab and Winkle Way. The focus comes from our key question 'Can one person change the world?' We will then be reading 'The Day the Crayons Quit' - a wonderfully persuasive story. We will be writing persuasive letters.

Maths: This term, we will be learning about fractions. We will be learning about wholes, parts, halves, thirds, quarters and placing these fractions on number lines. We will also continue working on counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Later in the term, we will be learning to tell the time on an analogue clock. Please work on this at home too.

Science: On our Science learning journey this term, we will be consolidating topics. We will apply our knowledge and understanding to help a giant tortoise called Tessa who lives on The Galapagos Islands. We will link our previous learning about explorers and the travels of Darwin.

Humanities: We are continuing with our topic, "Can One Person Change the World?" This term, we are learning about the designers and engineers who made the Crab and Winkle Way. We will walk part of The Way and create our own maps.

Spanish: The children will focus on counting in Spanish to 10.

Music & Computing

This term, the children will be linking their Music and Computing to record and create music on the iPads.

PSHE:

Our topic this term, is "Relationships." We will be looking at families and friendships. We will discuss trusting friendships and how to navigate conflict if it arises.

Art & DT:

Our Art will be based around the work of Pablo Picasso and Antonin Gaudi. We will explore some of their work and will use them as inspiration for our own works of art.

PE:

One of our sessions will be developing table tennis skills and the other will focus on building key skills in netball.

RE:

Our learning will consider the key question: Who is a Muslim and what do they believe?
