Please have a look over our class curriculum for the coming term. Our enquiry question will be 'How do people celebrate?'

Learning Together to Enjoy and Achieve

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

This term we will be learning about 'collaboration' and what it means to work as a team. We will also be thinking about the importance of respecting others and how we can celebrate differences. Finally, we will be working as classes to perform our 'Christmas songs' on Tuesday 9th December.

Communication and Language:

We will be continuing to work on our 'Speaking and Listening' skills and will participate in news telling and discussions about celebrations. We will also take part in 'circle times' where we will share our thoughts and ideas. We will share the book "Confetti" by Dean Atta, using it to reinforce our understanding of key vocabulary.

Literacy:

We will be beginning our weekly guided reading sessions alongside our daily story times. We will continue to learn Phase 2 phonemes and practise the skill of segmenting and blending. The children will be supported to write using the phonemes and words we know. Later on, in the term we focus on writing with purpose by making Christmas lists, letters and cards.

Mathematics:

We will be learning the composition of numbers to 5 and also learn the properties and names of 2D shapes. Additionally, we will also continue our daily 'Mastering Number' lessons where our focus will be on subitising.

Physical Development:

This term we will begin weekly PE lessons in Dance. This will begin with a workshop focussed on the retelling of the story of "Rama and Sita". The children will be exploring different ways and levels to move their bodies and how this can alter in response to changes in pitch and tempo of the music.

Expressive Arts and Design:

This term, the children will be focussed on sculpture and manipulating malleable resources. Using clay, we will design and create our own diva lamps. We will also explore and recreate Rangoli patterns.

In Music, we will be learning and rehearsing a range of Christmas songs for our upcoming performance and be introduced to "The Nutcracker" by Tchaikovsky.

Understanding The World:

We will be learning about 'Bonfire night', 'Remembrance Day', 'Diwali' and 'Christmas'. We will also be thinking about celebrations our families might have, including religious celebrations and birthdays. We will explore these festivals and events and learn the importance of respecting each other and our differences.

Please look out for the homework every **Friday** on Google Classroom. Our PE day will be on a **Thursday**, so please send your child in wearing a suitable PE kit on this day. We would love for you to add any achievements from home on Tapestry for us to celebrate.
