Learning Together to Enjoy and Achieve

**English:** We will start the term with researching and publishing an information leaflet all about The Crab and Winkle Way. The focus comes from our key question: 'Can one person change the world?' We will then be reading 'The Day the Crayons Quit' - a wonderfully persuasive story. We will be writing persuasive letters.

**Maths:** This term, we will be learning about fractions. We will be learning about wholes, parts, halves, thirds, quarters and placing these numbers on number lines. We will also continue working on counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Later in the term, we will be learning to tell the time on an analogue clock. Please work on this at home too.

**Science:** On our Science learning journey this term, we will be consolidating topics. We will apply our knowledge and understanding to help a giant tortoise called Tessa who lives on The Galapagos Islands. We will link our previous learning about explorers and the travels of Darwin.

**Humanities:** We are continuing with our topic: "Can One Person Change the World?" This term, we are learning about the designers and engineers who made the Crab and Winkle Way. We will walk part of The Way and create our own maps. We will also look at the lives and impact of Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale.

### **Music & Computing**

Children will be using a computer to create music. They will listen to a variety of pieces of music and consider how music can make them think and feel. Learners will compare creating music digitally and non-digitally.

### **PSHE:**

Our topic this term, is "Relationships." We will be looking at families and friendships. We will discuss trusting friendships and how to navigate conflict if it arises.

### **Art:**

Our Art focus is Still Life. We will be looking at the works of various artists. The children will explore shading techniques and develop an understanding of perspective.

### **PE:**

One of our sessions will be based on various Athletics skills. The other will focus on building key skills in netball.

### **RE:**

Our learning will consider the key question: Who is a Muslim and what do they believe?

### **Spanish:**

We will be continuing to learn numbers and colours.

### **DT:**

We will be discussing where food comes from and its provenance. Using this knowledge, we will use our cutting and chopping skills to create our own fruit salad.
