We will be further developing our writing stamina as well writing for a range of different purposes. Our units of work will include performance poetry, instruction writing and the wonderful story, "The Enormous Crocodile" by Roald Dahl. In reading, our Year 1 children will be further developing their phonic knowledge and Year 2 will be answering questions about texts with greater accuracy.

Welcome Back!

We are so excited to get stuck into all of our work this term as well as all the great events that the summer term has to offer!



This term, we will finish our unit of work on fractions. From there, we will move onto time with a focus on using clocks to set and read times. Finally, we will be learning about position and direction. Alongside all this, we will be continuing to consolidate our learning from this year and applying our skills to a range of problem solving contexts.

Science

Our Science work this term will begin with a unit on plants. We will explore types of plants, different parts of plants and what they need to stay healthy. We will also be looking at a sustainability unit on wildlife and what we can do to protect it. Finally, we will be looking at seasonal changes in summer and collecting weather data which we will compare with other seasonal information we have gathered this year.

Computing

This term, we will be learning about algorithms. We will learn what they are, how to programme them and use what we learn to move simple robot mechanisms.

Our units this term begin with "Financial Capability" and this will involve looking at where money comes from, the differences between wants and needs and ways in which money can be saved. After half term, we will be moving onto RSE. This is taught in single year groups and more information will follow nearer the time. The RSE policy is available on our school website.

History and Geography

We will be concluding our Geography work with further comparisons between where we live and Kampong Ayer. Our History unit for this term is all about the eruption of Mount Vesuvius in Pompeii. We will meet Sappho and use evidence to explore what her life during Roman times and this significant event was like.

Art and DT

In DT this term, we will completing a food technology project with the outcome of making fruit kebabs. We will learn how to prepare food safely and use simple tools. In Art, our unit title is "Flora and Fauna" and will be exploring the natural world through various mediums.

Music

This term, we will be focusing on rhythm. We will listen to and appraise music from different genres and follow simple musical notation to create different rhythms.



This term, we will be building on skills we have been developing earlier in the year as we complete units of work in striking and fielding as well as invasion games. As we move into the second part of the term, we will move onto athletics in preparation for Sports Day!

RE

This term we will exploring our learning question "How should we care for others and the world and why does it matter? We will think carefully about different ways that Christians and Jews care for people of the world, including giving to charities, and how this action links to teachings found within the Bible and the Torah.
