### Advance Notice: Oaks Nursery Car Park Closure

We want to give families advance notice that from **7**<sup>th</sup> **July - 4**<sup>th</sup> **August**, resurfacing work will begin on Parkwood Road, which will close access to the Oaks Nursery car park. This will cause significant disruption and delays for those travelling to and from school.

There will be a signed diversion route that will be in place through the Kent University housing complex. Along this route, there are a three small car parks that may offer limited parking. We're grateful to Kent University, who have kindly continued to allow our parents and carers to park considerately in these areas during drop-off and pick-up times.

If you plan to use the diversion route, please allow extra time, drive carefully, and be mindful of residents. Where possible, we encourage families to walk, cycle or scoot to school to help ease congestion. We're sharing this early so you can plan ahead. Thank you for your understanding and support.
