

## **Consett Academy Contextual Information for Higher Education Providers (2021)**

### **COVID-19 Implications for current cohort**

On Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March, Consett Academy Sixth Form closed due to Government guidelines. At this time staff were required to upload work and resources for remote learning. No live teaching took place.

From Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June, Year 12 students returned to Sixth Form for five weeks, receiving two hours of face-to-face teaching per subject, per week. Teachers set supplementary work to be completed independently. The work continued to follow the subject specifications, however no formal assessments in controlled conditions were able to take place during this time.

Throughout September we have been under local restrictions, limiting the opportunities for field work to be carried out.

Between September 5<sup>th</sup> to October 12<sup>th</sup>, 66% of Year 13 had to self-isolate for two weeks. During this time, lessons were taught remotely.
