term of Year 6.

Learning Together to Enjoy and Achieve

English and Geography: We will begin the term by completing our Great Amazon Expedition and draw all the different pieces to a conclusion. As part of our wider learning about the Amazon Rainforest, we will also be exploring deforestation and sustainability, linking this to our local area of Blean Woods.

Maths: We will be using our measuring skills to create nets of 3d models. We will then learn about linear sequences and how we can find the nth term of a sequence. We will continually recap our calculation skills and will finish off by designing our own theme park.

Science: Our Science topic continues with Evolution and Inheritance. We will also be revising the scientific understanding of human lifecycles and reproduction linking with our PSHE work.

RE: We will look at the connections between beliefs and behaviour in different religions. We will explore the importance of the concepts of Ahimsa (to Hindus) and the Ummah (to Muslims).

PSHE: Our PSHE will have two strands: we will be discussing reproduction as part of our 'Changing Me' focus (more information to follow). We will also be looking at transition to Secondary School giving the pupils a chance to look at practicalities, challenges and responsibility.

Drama, Art, Music, DT, Dance:

We will be combining all of these subjects in our year group production of 'Robin Hood'. As well as acting and singing, the children will be engaged in set design, prop-making, costume design and choreography. We know that we can rely on all parents and pupils to be supportive of our endeavours as the children will need to show all of our school values as they take on this exciting challenge.

Computing:

The children will bring all of their prior learning together, using all of their coding skills to code and use a micro:bit. The children will take on new projects in each lesson to further develop their skills ending with a final project-creating a step counter.

Spanish:

This term, the children will review and extend their previous learning to build on their understanding of tenses, vocabulary and grammar while developing their speaking and writing skills in creative contexts like comic strips.

P.E. and Games:

PE will be on Tuesdays and Fridays this term, with both sessions being outside. We will be practising our athletics skills ready for Sports Day and developing our teamwork skills through playing rounders.

Please ensure PE kits are in school every day.
