Learning Together to Enjoy and Achieve

English: Our English writing this term will focus on an expedition to The Amazon Rainforest. We will be using extracts from books and other stimuli to generate writing using a range of genres. We will also be revising all of our Grammar and Reading skills ready for the SATs.

Maths: In Maths, we will be measuring angles and drawing shapes. We will be using our knowledge of angles in triangles, quadrilaterals and other polygons to solve problems involving calculating missing angles. We will continue to practise our arithmetic skills, particularly reviewing calculations involving fractions, percentages and long division.

Science: Our Science topic this term is Adaptation, Evolution and Inheritance. We will look at Darwin's contributions to understanding Evolution and the ways we inherit characteristics from previous generations.

Geography:

This term, our topic is South America. We will be researching human and physical features of this continent with a specific focus on Brazil and the Amazon Rainforest.

PSHE:

In PSHE, our topic is 'Relationships' where we will explore themes such as mental health, love and loss, and being responsible when online.

R.E.

This term, we will ask the question: 'How can belief affect actions?' We will explore the connections between belief and behaviour within different religions.

P.E. and Games:

This term, we will learn the skills to play the batting and fielding games of longball and rounders. Alongside this, we will develop our athletic skills of running, jumping and throwing.

Spanish:

This term, Year 6 will learn about tapas culture in Spain, including expressing opinions on food and drinks. They will learn how to politely order at a tapas bar and practice this in role play.

Art:

We will be using watercolours to create landscapes and images linked to our Science and Geography topics.

Computing:

Children will develop their knowledge and understanding of using a computer to produce 3D models. They will plan, develop, and evaluate their own 3D model of a building.
