We are delighted to share that we have successfully achieved the SEND Award, reflecting our ongoing commitment to supporting pupils with SEND and ensuring they receive high-quality, inclusive education. The award recognises our work in removing barriers to learning through early identification, inclusive teaching and strong leadership, as well as celebrating positive classroom practice and outcomes for our pupils.

A huge thank you to Miss Llewellyn for all the time and care taken in compiling the evidence and to our whole staff team and wider stakeholders for their continued support.

Also this week, we welcomed 16 visitors from local primary and secondary schools, as well as Christchurch University, who came to see our school research projects in action. They were extremely impressed by both our school and our pupils. The feedback we received included:
