Saturday 17th May - 10am start

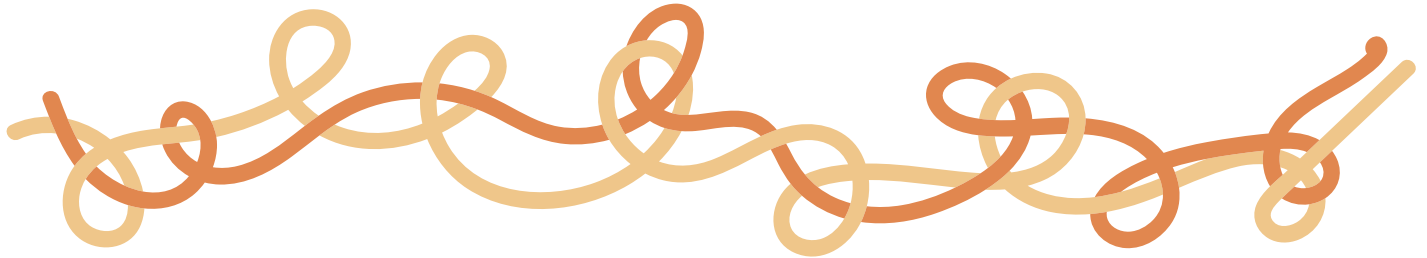
Saturday 7th June - tbc start
