LEARNING, TEACHING AND SAFEGUARDING (LTS) COMMITTEE

The aim is for the LTS committee meet 6 times per year (1 meeting per half-term). 50% of governors need to be present to make the meeting quorum.

Terms of Reference

LEARNING:

- O To review the school's aims and objectives and make recommendations to the Governing Board and update the Governing Board's Strategic Aims.
- o To advise the GB on target setting and monitor the progress towards agreed targets.
- o To monitor the implementation of the National Curriculum.
- To review the School's Self Evaluation termly and to report back to the GB i.e. Quality of Education. Personal Development, Behaviour and Attitude, Leadership and Overall Effectiveness.
- To receive the School Plan through the year to make recommendations to the Governing Board for adoption, monitoring and evaluation.
- To hear appeals against the decision of the Headteacher in relation to a direction of temporary exception from the National Curriculum.
- o To consider requests by the Headteacher to extend a general direction in relation to the National Curriculum beyond its original term a minimum of 3 governors required.
- o To advise the Finance, Staffing and Premises committee on the relative funding priorities necessary to deliver the Quality of Education.
- o To undertake the Governing Board self review.
- o To respond to pupil and parental questionnaire analysis and attempt to address issues raised.

TEACHING:

- To review the provision for and progress the school is making with regard to Every Child Matters, Extended Schools and Healthy Schools.
- o To aim to ensure that all pupils are given equality of access to the curriculum.
- o To review the prospectus, handbook and Home School Agreement.
- o To be aware of current, and promote future links, with the local community.
- To ensure the school's Inclusion Policies are reviewed and make recommendations to the GB in conjunction with the Inclusion link governor and the Inclusion Leader where appropriate.
- o To review and discuss how to use Pupil Premium Grant to support disadvantaged pupils.

SAFEGUARDING:

- o To ensure the school has appropriate safeguarding measures in place for children, including the appointment of a named Educational Visits Co-ordinator.
- o To review the Behaviour Policy and Anti-Bullying Policy and make recommendations to the GB
- o To monitor and review pupil attendance.
- o To review and comment an overview of the Vulnerable Children's Grid.
- o To ensure the school has a Single Central Record in place that is Ofsted Compliant.
