English

Maths

We will be beginning with our unit on place value looking at numbers up to 10,000,000 before moving on to the four operations including long division. We will also be working very hard on improving our arithmetic scores with weekly revision and practice.

RE

In RE, we will be looking at why some people believe in God and some do not making clear connections between the impact of this belief on how they live.

AUTUMN 1

History

How did a pile of dragon bones help to solve an Ancient Chinese mystery? Our first topic will be on the Shang Dynasty looking at how the reign of King Cheng Tang compared with that of King Di Xin before finishing with what made Fu Hao stand out from the crowd.

French

In French, we will be learning how to say the date, including the days of the week, months of the year and consolidating numbers to give birthday information.

Art
