## Term 2 - Forest School

In Term 2, Key Stage 2 will continue their Forest School sessions. Children will change into their Forest School clothes before the session begins. Please pack Forest School clothes in a separate bag, ensuring all items are named and are suitable for outdoor play in any weather conditions.

#### Your child will need to wear:

- A long-sleeved top
- Full-length trousers
- Wellies, sturdy shoes, or boots

- Extra layers in case of cold or wet weather
