





Our Understanding of Spirituality

<p>Self: Children learn to understand their own identity - who they are, how they feel and what makes them unique.</p> 	<p>Others: Children develop empathy and compassion by exploring how their values and choices affect those around them.</p> 
<p>Beauty: Children discover wonder in nature, art and music, experiencing how beauty can inspire and uplift us.</p> 	<p>Beyond: Children explore life's big questions - our purpose, our place in the world and, for believers, our relationship with God.</p>
