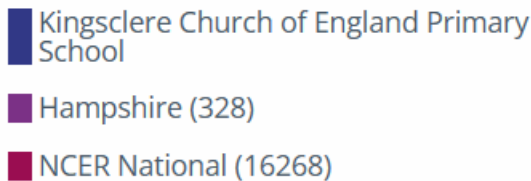


Kingsclere CE Primary School Year 6 – End of Key Stage 2 SAT Results 2019, 2022 and 2023

The bar charts below show results for children in Year 6 at the end of Key Stage 2 in Reading, Writing, Maths and Science. There were 31 children in Year 6 in 2023 - 14 boys and 17 girls.

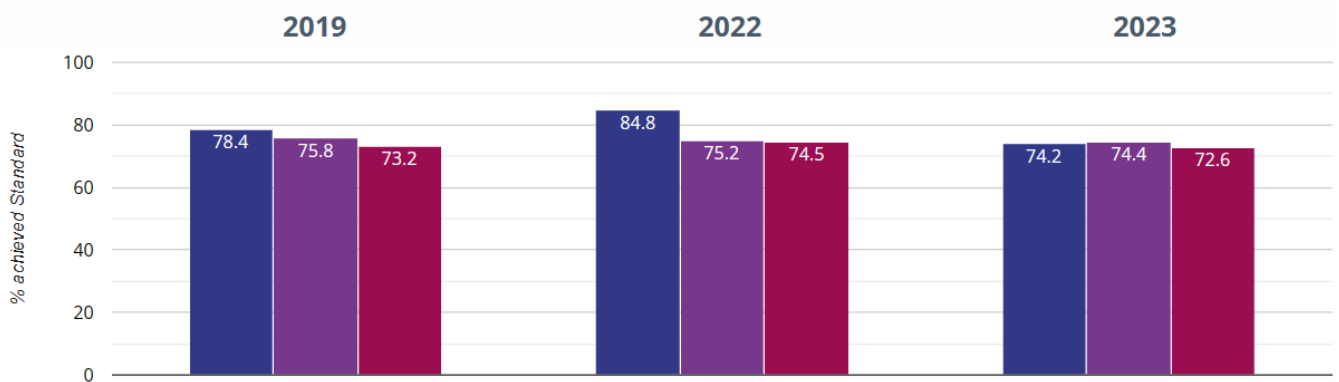
Pupils progress score averages, for our 2023 cohort, are above 2019 progress scores in Reading, Writing and Maths and 2022 progress scores in 2022 in Reading and Writing.



Reading Year 6 – End of Key Stage 2 – 2019, 2022 and 2023

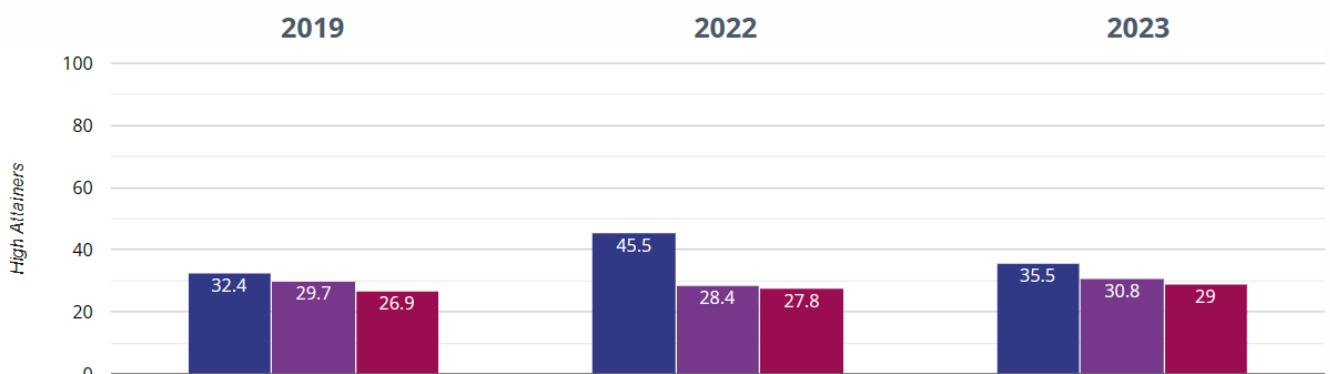
In 2023, 74.2% of our Kingsclere CE Primary School Year 6 children achieved the expected standard (EXS) in Reading which is above national and in line with Hampshire averages.

Reading - achieved standard



In 2023, 35.5% of our Year 6 children achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in Reading. This GDS attainment places us above national and Hampshire averages.

Reading - high attainers

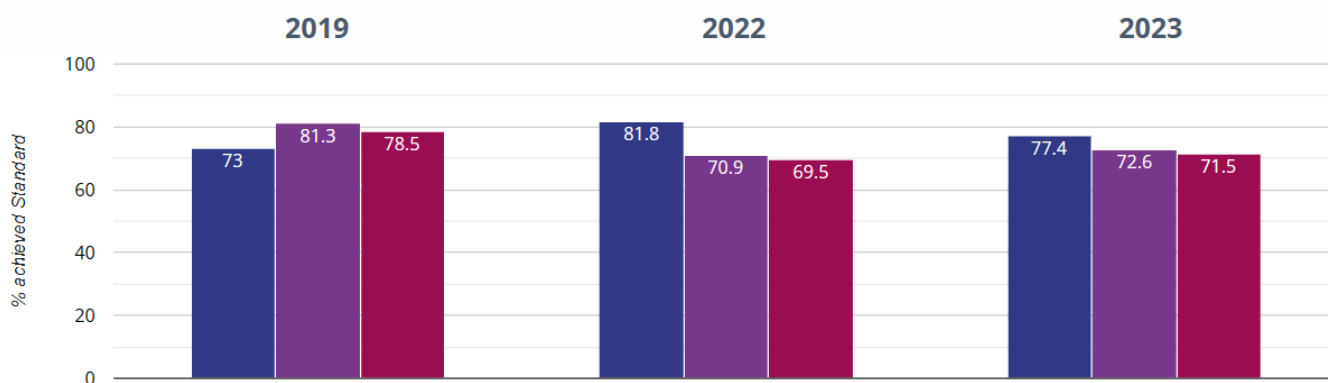


Our school improvement planning focus for 2023 - 2024 will be to continue to achieve EXS and GDS percentages above national and Hampshire averages.

Writing – Year 6 – End of Key Stage 2 - 2019, 2022 and 2023

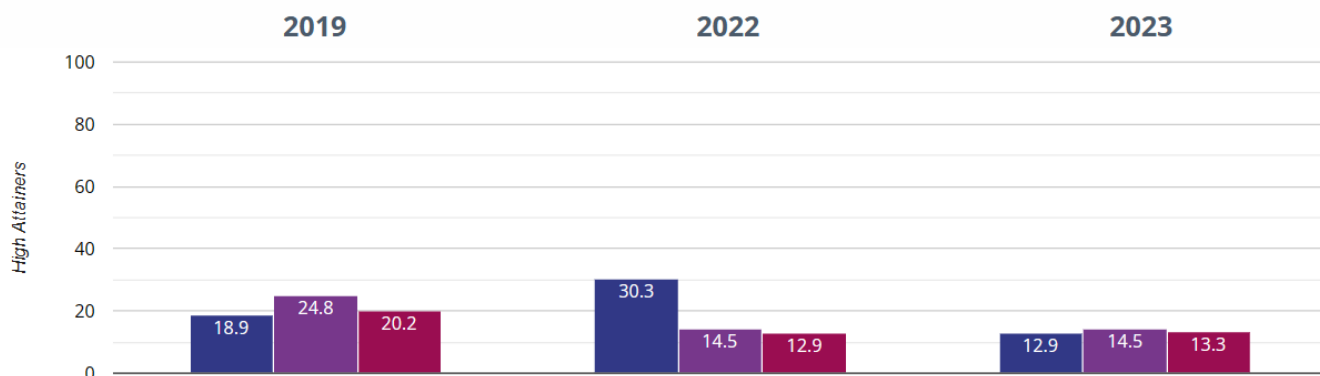
77.4% of our Year 6 children achieved the expected standard in Writing in 2023. This percentage score is above the national and Hampshire averages.

12.9% of our Year 6 children achieved Greater Depth Standard (GDS) in writing in 2023.

Writing - high attainers

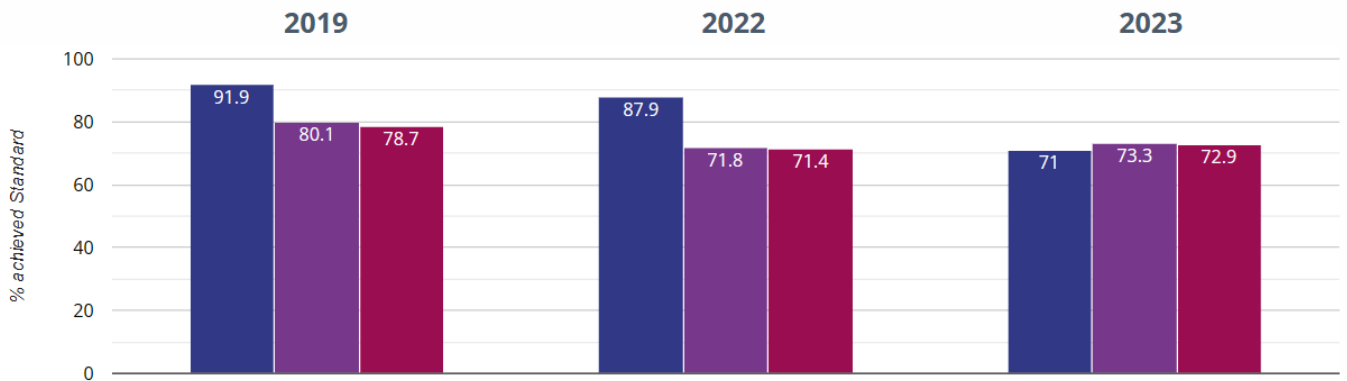


Our 2023 Year 6 cohort progress scores were significantly above 2019 and 2023 progress scores in Reading and Maths and above our pre-Covid 2019 Year 6 cohort by +2.97% in Writing.

Maths – Year 6 – End of Key Stage 2 - 2019, 2022 and 2023

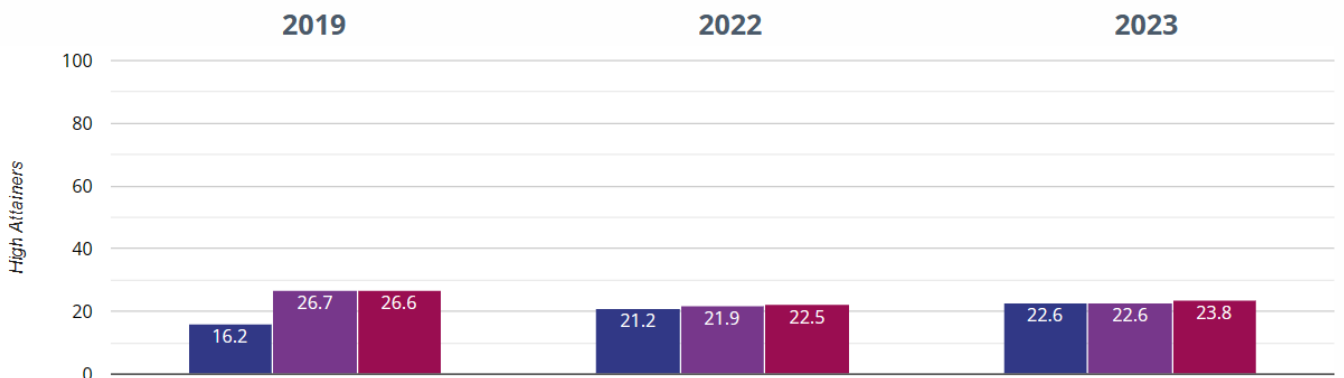
In 2023, 71% of our Year 6 children achieved the expected standard in Maths which was close to national and Hampshire averages.

+ Maths - high attainers

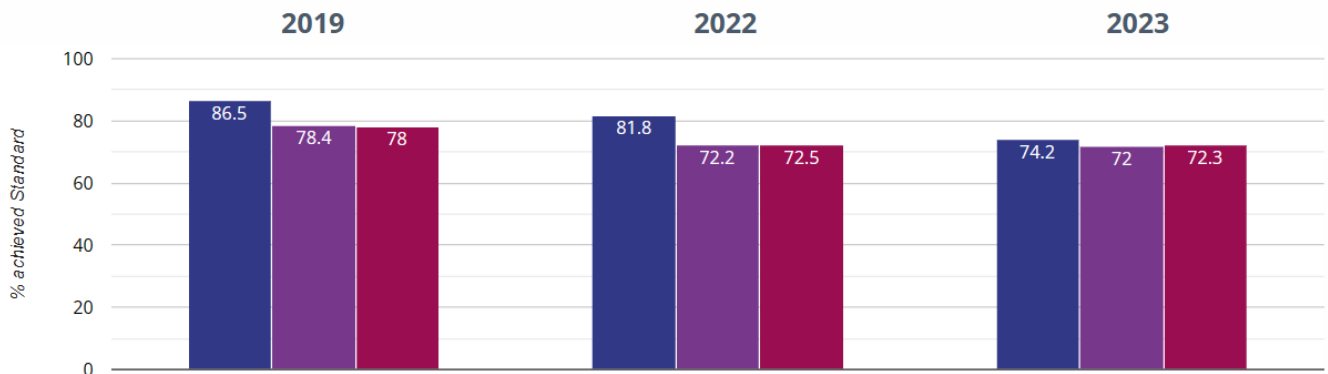


Our school improvement planning focus for 2023 - 2024 will be to achieve EXS and GDS percentages above national and Hampshire averages.

Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling – Year 6 – End of Key Stage 2 – 2019, 2022 and 2023

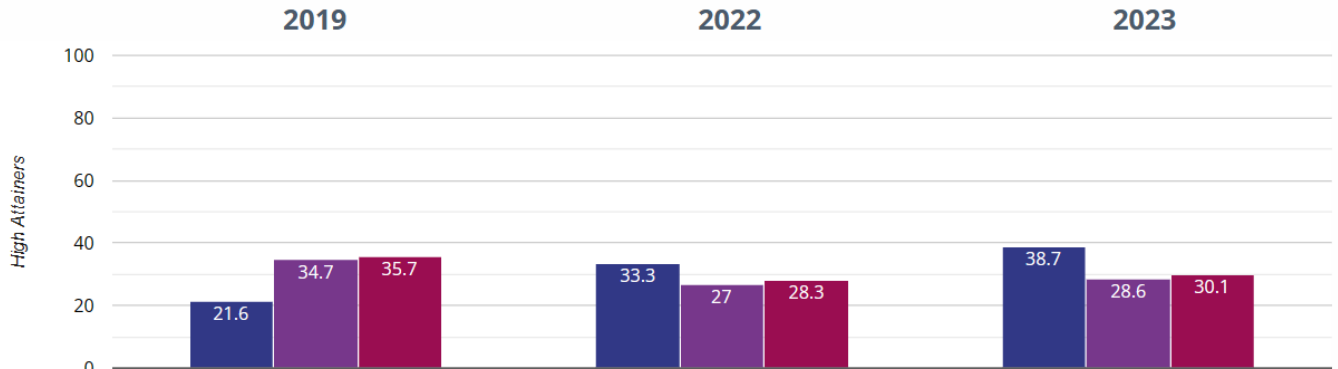
74.2% of children achieved the expected standards in 2023 which were above national and Hampshire standards.

38.7% of our Year 6 children achieved Greater Depth standards in 2023 which was above national and Hampshire standards.

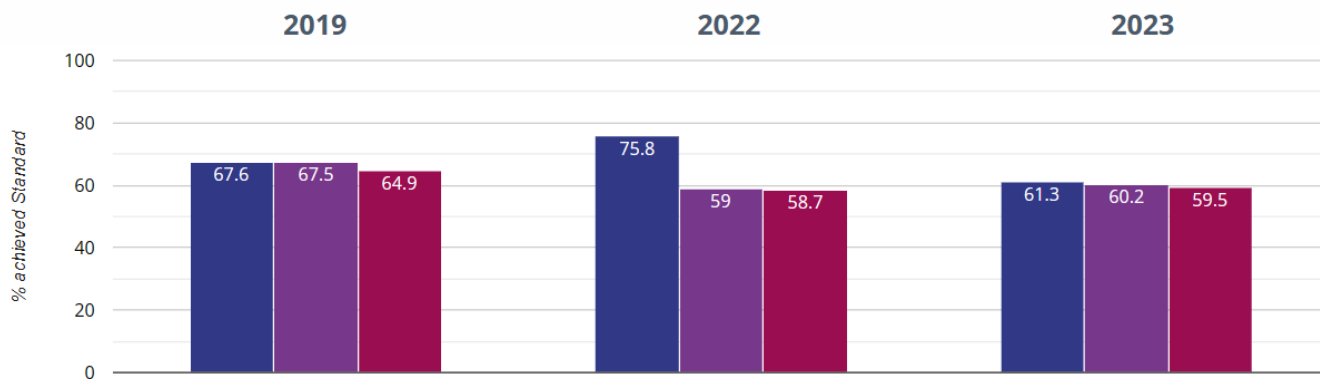

Combined results (Reading, Writing and Maths) in Year 6 – 2019, 2022 and 2023

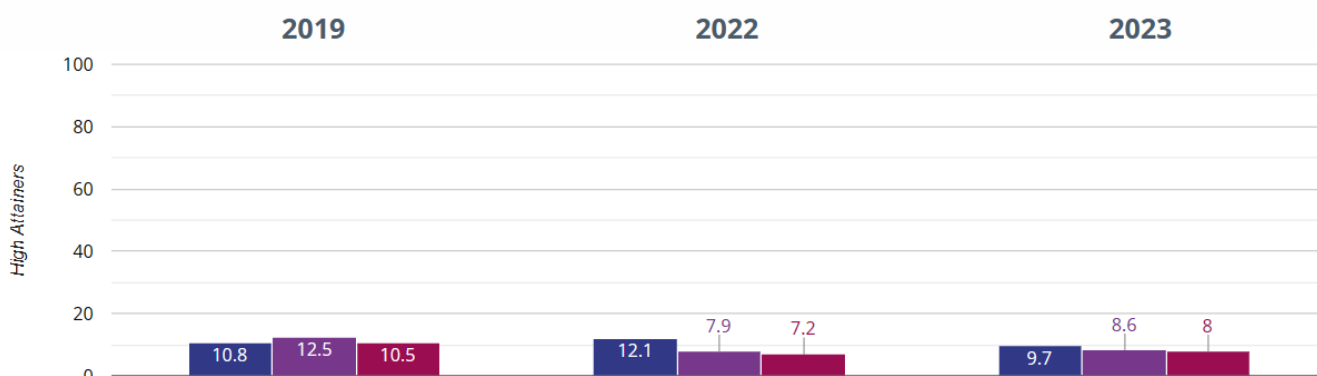
In 2023, 61.3% of children in Year 6 achieved the Expected Standard (EXS) in Reading, Writing and Mathematics which is above the national and Hampshire averages.

The number of children achieving combined Greater Depth in 2023 is 9.7% and above National and Hampshire averages.

Science – Year 6 – End of Key Stage 2

In 2023, 84% of our Year 6 children achieved the expected standard in Science which is above the national average.
